Homecoming fun games will be held on the Library Quad from 3 to 5 p.m. Wednesday, Oct. 10. The games include Blind Dressing the Blind, Shopping Cart 500, and the Milk Shake Chug-A-Lug.

On Thursday, Oct. 11, a bonfire/pep rally featuring the EIU Marching Band, Pink Panthers, Coach Bob Spoo, and the football team will be held at Lawson/Taylor Courts from 8 to 10 p.m.

Homecoming Day, Saturday Oct. 13, is highlighted with the traditional Homecoming parade, beginning at 9:30 a.m. on Seventh Street and Lincoln Avenue. It will proceed northbound on Seventh Street, circle the Square, and then march down Sixth Street.

A pre-game pep rally will follow the parade from noon to 2 p.m. on the west side of O'Brien Stadium. The football game between EIU and Indiana State begins at 2 p.m.
