TEXAS

Texas broiler operators placed 5.23 million chicks during the week, an increase of 14 percent from last year and 3 percent from the previous week. Placements were up 7 percent from the first of the month.

The weekly hatch, at 5.65 million chicks, was 82 percent of the eggs set during the week of June 7. The hatch was up 5 percent from a year ago but down 1 percent from last week.

Producers set 6.18 million eggs, 6 percent above a year earlier. The set was down 11 percent from the previous week.

Texas producers shipped 389,000 broiler chicks to Arkansas and Alabama. No inshipments were received during the week.

TWELVE STATES

In the twelve leading broiler producing states weekly placements totaled 85.64 million chicks, an increase of 2 percent from last year and up slightly from the previous week.

The weekly egg set was 6 percent above a year ago at 105.29 million. The set was down 5 percent from last week.
