For week ending June 20, 1981 Released: June 25, 1981

TEXAS

Eggs set during the week ending June 20, 1981, totaled 348,000, according to the Texas Crop and Livestock Reporting Service. This was 2 percent above a year ago, and 9 percent above the previous week. Poults hatched during the week totaled 209,000, 10 percent below a year ago, but 7 percent above the previous week.

Thus far this season, 6,010,000 poults have been hatched, 26 percent below the same period a year ago.

NINE STATES

The nine states in the weekly program reported a total of 5,489,000 eggs set, 9 percent above the previous year, but remained the same as a week ago. Poults hatched during the week totaled 3,865,000, up 1 percent from a year ago, and up 2 percent from the previous week.

Thus far this season, 115,438,000 poults have been hatched, slightly above the corresponding period the previous year.

TURKEYS TESTED - BY OFFICIAL STATE AGENCIES

TEXAS

There were no heavy breed turkeys tested for pullorum-typhoid disease in May 1981.

For the 1980-81 season, 163,943 birds were tested, compared with 375,698 a year ago.

UNITED STATES

Testings of heavy breed turkeys during May totaled 128,529, down 33 percent from 1980. Light breeds tested totaled 15,000 compared with 26,938 the same month last year.

Thus far this season, 2,810,716 heavy breeds and 177,210 light breeds have been tested.
