Thesis Project:

Each student will produce a thesis final project. Projects vary from moving image work, an application, a web experience, a virtual experience, etc.

An instructor will work on an individual level with each student to guide them through the conceptual and technical process.

Goal:

To continue guiding and directing students with their final thesis projects. On an individual basis and in virtual group sessions.

Individual discussions about student work, ideas, and technicalities should seamlessly be integrated into an online experience.

Plan:

Twice a week, students must log-in to Canvas discussions boards, and upload their project files. Each student is required to give feedback to one other student in the comment section. Participation in the discussion board will count as attendance. The instructor then read and follow with feedback for each student.

Once a week, virtual video chat will be provided by the instructor with further instructions and information for individual students. Each student also will show the progress of their projects via screen-share, to present the process.
