










New website





I am extremely disappointed in the new Central Florida Memory website. The St. Cloud Tribune digital archive used to be presented in a generally user-friendly format. One could easily page through the chronological list of all available editions & select the desired time frame. Each individual issue was text-searchable, & users had the option of downloading individual pages. The previous format was certainly imperfect, but all in all, was rather more streamlined than the new system.

The current Central Florida Memory website might be new, but it is in no way improved. It's unnecessarily fussy, & adds several additional steps to the process of locating/accessing issues or articles. No longer having the option of downloading individual pages adds yet another level of complications. Users will now have to download an entire edition (including numerous unwanted pages), then use editing software to extract the one page they wanted. The elimination of text-searchability within a given edition is a loss to any historian.

The St. Cloud Tribune digital archive has been an indispensable research tool for years, of which I made frequent use. The user & viewer-friendly features mentioned above have enabled me to quickly & easily find information needed for many of the 61 military headstones I've obtained for veterans buried in St. Cloud. I have used articles & entire pages in numerous educational presentations.

Historical research can be an arduous process, & you have not made my task any easier.
