





# ALTERNATIVE FOR REVOLUTION

Okay, so nobody's gonna hassle the fact that the straight society is a little fluked. It's pretty easy to see through their phony games. And all the religious weirdos who think they've got all the answers to everything that ever was—they're a little spacy, too!

So what are you going to do? The establishment hassles us because we don't dig their synthetic life-style. The church groupies think we need to rotate around their own little brick building and take a liturgical trip. And all their memorized answers to questions nobody even asks makes us want to shine it on to anything good they might have to say.

We know we need a revolutionary solution. That's cool. But what? I mean, who can you really trust when everybody is piping his own tune?

When we don't dig something, we have to choose from a number of alternatives: 1) Put up with the hassle 2) Ignore it and hope it'll go away 3) try to smash it or destroy it 4) Find a constructive alternative solution.

It's pretty obvious that the first three reactions are inadequate. They only Compound the problem. But the fourth one gets a little heavy. I mean, who's to say what a "constructive alternative" really is.

All right, let's get serious. It's pretty obvious that apathy is not where its at. War, ego-power, plastic values—they're all bummers, too. But we might as well get one thing straight right now! We're finally coming to the brilliant conclusion that something is wrong with man on the inside or we wouldn't be in this mess. Dig?

So what does that mean? It means we gotta get changed on the <u>inside</u>, that's what! All your ecology programs, and ghetto renewal plans, and religious formulas are all a bunch of garbage until man is changed. We've had thousands of years to improve on human behavior. But we haven't managed to change anything yet. Don't give me that jazz about man is getting better. That's a bunch of flack.

Man's behavior is not linear. It doesn't start at one point and automatically shoot in a celestial direction. Maybe "technological progress" does (whatever that is), but man's moral behavior doesn't. It's not linear; it's cyclical. You dig? The life-style of homo sapiens follows a cycle. Just look at history.

What we need to do is get off this spinning wheel. But we can't jump off by ourselves. We're stuck, and, needless to say, we're all getting pretty dizzy.

Fortunately, there was one man who visited our spinning wheel who had his head screwed on straight. He really had things scoped out. He wasn't hung up on the inside like everybody else, either. His head was together and He laid down some heavy vibes. He said, "All of you who are wiped out, or dizzy with guilt and self-defeat, and anybody else who is bent out of shape—come to me and I will liberate your head, give you eternal rest, and change you on the inside so that you can really groove in an ungroovy world."

Jesus really had the low-down on how to make it. And his alternative for revolution was constructive. No blood, no guts, no bad-mouthing the local heavies, no ego-tripping with super pious religious formulas. Just far out love and eternal bliss and a peace that transcends the grooviest high any drug could give.

Jesus didn't come to "show us how to" live, or to start a new organization, or to compete with the other religious superstars. Jesus doesn't offer religion. He offers Himself, and only Himself as the solution—with no rules or formulas attached.


Jesus wants you to get it on right now. I mean, like His trip is for real and you won't crash if you let Him live His life in you. Dig it? That's what He wants to do. He doesn't want to show you how you can do it yourself. "Do-it-yourself religion" has been around for centuries and it hasn't gotten us anywhere.



No, Jesus wants to change you. Let Him do it. Just step aside and give Him permission to do His thing. You can trust Him. He loves you personally and He wants to prove Himself to you. So give Him a fair shake. Dig?

When Jesus starts living His life through you things will change. I mean, like you won't want to be the bad-mouthing creep you used to be. And you won't want to pollute your environment or abuse the natural function of living either. He takes you off your spinning wheel and puts your head back together.

Jesus' revolutionary alternative really works. It's spiritual, not religious. Get the difference? His trip isn't plastic, that's all! What he wants you to do is to drop out of your hang-ups and to drop into His revolutionary love. With Jesus pulling for you, you can't lose. After all, He is God!!







Andy Warhol's new film, "Trash," is not just another experiment in pornography. It does nothing that wasn't done in "The Magic Garden of Stanley Sweetheart" or "MASH," so for Warhol it could be called a "conservative" film. But it does more of what the others do, and in a more realistic, and therefore, more shocking way. In "Trash" the nude scenes and sex acts are central, rather than incidental, to the film.

The plot, if it can be called that, is that heroin-"trash"--has made the hero unable to have sex and therefore useless in the culture he moves in.

The film's artistic quality is limited to its sensuality, but it lacks the most basic ingredient for art--religious conviction. Though it is more sensual and heavier in terms of interpreting reality than Warhol's previous films, it doesn't go beyond "Nude Restaurant" in being spiritually meaningful.

There is nothing religious about sitting around a bar, nude or otherwise, discussing your hang-ups and wierd relatives. It takes neither love, hatred, character, dedication, ambition, motivation, delusion, charity, beauty, imagination, or wit. So far as being a truly meaningful statement on any issue of life is concerned, "Trash" is just trash.

Trash is one of the roads that leads to destruction in our generation; faster, and therefore more efficiently, than many others, but no less deadly. Any high you can buy--dope, power, religion, music, meditation--has as its goal the same dead end. There's only one way that ends in life, and that is Life Himself, Jesus Christ.



Where's the revolution? What happened to Abbie? Where's Huey? All I see is a lot of long-haired kids running around with smiles on their faces and Bibles

Where are all the guns that were gonna be handed out when the revolution came? All I ever get handed is printed pamphlets about the revolution, and they're even more active than they were before, but it's not the same revolution I know.

I thought when the revolution came we were gonna destroy the old ways and make some real changes. My friends tell me the revolution is already here. That Jesus is the revolution. That the Holy Spirit is the change. That God will show me the new way. Hmmmmm. Well, I'm almost persuaded.

### A Letter From a U.S. Soldier in Vietnam to His Sister in the United States

I don't know where to start first. So many things have happened since I last wrote to you. Well, to begin with I have escaped death at the hands of the enemy in a way so amazing I am still in a daze. You remember I told you I was going over armed with the Bible too? That Bible is the reason I am still here and able to write this letter to all America. Here is the story:

My buddy and I were sent out on duty with our equipment in the work I told you before was our job. We had just received information-the most important for weeks. But we were discovered by

I gave my buddy the information we had collected, told him to beat it, and prepared myself to face the enemy. It was the first time I had been face-to-face with the necessity of pointing my gun at a man to shoot the life from his body. I thought fast; then I said, "Lord, it's Your responsibility now."

As I reached for my carbine a shot from one of them struck me in the breast and blasted me down. But my buddy had not obeyed my order. He had not gone. Thinking I was dead, he turned for me, grabbed my carbine as well as his own, stood astride my body, and blasted away with both guns. He was hit too-his knees with three bullet wounds. But when he finished there was not one of

He was amazed when I rolled over and tried to get up. The force of the bullet had only stunned me. Dazedly I wondered why, I pulled that little Bible out of my pocket and in utter muteness looked at the ugly hole in the cover. . . It had ripped through Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, through Samuel, Kings and kept going. Where do you think it stopped? In the middle of Psalm 91, pointing like a finger at this verse—"A thousand shall fall at thy side, and ten thousand at thy right hand, but it shall not come nigh thee." Sis, when I read that verse, it raised me off the ground. I did not know there was such a verse in the Bible. I'd been reading mostly in the New Testament. In utter humility I said, "Thank you precious God."

When I got my buddy back to the post, he said, "This convinces me. I want to get right with God." He wouldn't even let them tend his wounds, saying, "Nothing matters now but this". Falling on the knee with the three wounds, he prayed until his body became almost numb. But he wouldn't give up. And when he knew the Lord had heard his cry, and had come into his heart and saved him, he ran outside and shouted to the whole camp.


Sis, since that time I have talked with the boys, held meetings and prayed with them. Twenty-five of the men have come out for God. God has even reached my general.

I tell you, Sis, prayer is going to win this war. Not guns alone. Fervent, agonizing prayer.

Pray Sis, pray as you have never prayed before. Tell everyone to pray. Tell all America to go on its knees. Until nations and people have paid in blood and tears for thrusting God out of their hearts, out of their homes, nations and lands, this war will not end.

Tell them to send Bibles, and more Bibles. A Bible will give a soldier the confidence that God is with him. Try to get this letter on the air, in the papers, in anything that is printed. Make copies of it. Send it from coast to coast. Tell the American complacent, bridge-playing, cocktail drinking mothers, "Why didn't you teach your sons about God instead of handing them a cigarette, a cocktail glass, and a dance program? Ask the preachers why they didn't teach their young people to pray. I could go on but I'm

As I write this, I am about to leave for L.A. after spending one week here at the University of Illinois at the largest student convention of Jesus People in history, over 12,000 students from more than 70 countries of the

The emphasis here was on becoming a missionary which all over the world were here to tell us about how God is liberating the oppressed people everywhere--and yet, the workers are few. We heard one student from Indonesia cry for Black Christian Missionaries because they are so successful with the Indonesian people.

Tom Skinner, former Harlem gang leader, spoke on "The White Problem" in his lecture on EVANGELISM and RACISM. This received a standing ovation from all 12,000 students as Tom Skinner called for integration of social action and proclamation of the Gospel

The exciting "Soul Liberation" provided music and was enthusiastically received both in large arena gatherings and smaller informal gatherings. The group consists of about 15 black students from New York City. One of their most popular songs was "I Don't want to Gang War, I Don't Want to Kill My Brother No More." Twice a day, everyday, there were over 1200 small Bible Study and prayer groups meeting. In these meetings students expressed how they had just come into a new

racist attitudes had been broken down. On Wednesday, we got word that our 5,000 HOLLYWOOD FREE PAPERS--the New Year's issue, had arrived at the airport. That evening 7 of us from Fullerton, Calif. handed out the Paper. Everywhere you looked students were reading the paper. It was quite a sight. There were over 40 seminars to go to including "Occultsm" and "Eastern Mysticism" which I was finally able to queeze in by going a half hour early. On Wednesday eve. till after 2 a.m. Thurs. morn., there was a Black-White caucus with about 300 black and white students packed into the room. We discussed the "White Problem" and the getting of ourselves together in Jesus. The problem of the police was brought out. One could feel the presence of Jesus in the room, especially at the end when our Black Brothers prayed for the police, their white brothers, and themselves. Most of all, we affirmed our unity in Christ.

The grand finale of the convention came at 11 p.m. on New Year's Eve as we celebrated the Communion of our LORD. With the breaking of the bread, we reaffirmed our commitments to Christ and each other as the Lord Jesus Christ sent us forth at 12:15 a.m. New Year's Day into the Third World--the oppressed people of the world--everyone who doesn't know Jesus.






