



GOD LEADS A SHELIERED SHELIERED At the end of time, billions of people were

At the end of time, billions of people were scattered on a great plain before God's throne. Some of the groups near the front talked heatedly, not with cringing shame, but with belligerence.

"How can God judge us?" "How can He know about suffering?" snapped a joking brunette. She jerked back a sleeve to reveal a tatooed number from a Nazi concentration camp. "We endured terror, beatings, torture, and death!"

In another group, a black man lowered his collar. "What about this?" he demanded, showing an ugly rope burn. "Lynched for no crime but being black!" "We have suffocated in slave ships, been wrenched from loved ones, toiled till only death gave release."

Far out across the plain were hundreds of such groups. Each had a complaint against God for the evil and suffering He permitted in His world. How lucky God was to live in heaven where all was sweetness and light, where there was no weeping, no fear, no hunger, no hatred. Indeed, what did God know about what man had been forced to endure in this world? "After all, God leads a pretty sheltered life, " they said.

So each group sent out a leader, chosen because he had suffered the most. There was a Jew, a black, an untouchable from India, an illegitimate, a person from Hiroshima, and one from a Siberian slave camp. In the center of the plain they consulted with each other. At last they were ready to present their case. It was rather simple: Before God would be qualified to be their judge, He must endure what they had endured. Their decision was that God "should be sentenced to live on earth - as a man!"

But because He was God, they set certain safeguards to be sure He could not use His divine powers to help Himself. Let Him be born a Jew. Let the legitimacy of His birth be doubted, so that one will know who is really His father. Let Him champion a cause so just, but so radical, that it brings down upon Him the hate, condemnation, and eliminating efforts of every major traditional and established religious authority. Let Him try to communicate what no man has ever seen, tasted, heard, or smelled - God. Let Him be betrayed by His dearest friends. Let Him be indicted on false charges, tried before a prejudiced jury, and convicted by a cowardly judge. Let Him see what it is to be terribly alone and completely abandoned by every living thing. Let Him be tortured and let Him die! Let Him die the most humiliating death - with common thieves.

As each leader announced his portion of the sentence, loud murmurs of approval went up from the great throng of people. When the last had finished pronouncing sentence, there was a long silence. No one uttered another word. No one moved. For suddenly all knew... God had already served His sentence.



Jesus is a "thought-crime" punishable by death. All Jesus meetings are secret and underground. Bibles are scarce, so, individual pages are ripped out, memorized, and passed on to other Christians. Watchman Nee, an outspoken follower in the underground Jesus movement, is arrested as a ringleader. (His books have helped to convert thousands of Chinese to the salvation of Jesus.) The authorities imprison him but are afraid to kill him; afraid he will become a martyr and that thousands more will accept Jesus. So they silence him with imprisonment. Yet the flow of his writing continues. They discover that the guards have been converted, and are smuggling out his books page by page. They kill the guards but the flow continues. Guard after guard is converted. Guard after guard is killed. Finally, the arms of Watchman Nee are cut off. Yet the flow continues.

His books are translated into many languages including English. Thousands more come to know Jesus as they read. These books proclaim the joy of freedom in Jesus, the liberation through the spirit; all written by a man who has been in prison for years. Watchman Nee knows what he speaks of...he's been able to put it to the test. Spiritual liberation. Personal peace. Freedom, if you want it. It's real, and it's now.

Watchman Nee is finally released from prison by the Communist government, in a political play for public sympathy, and a hope that the Christian fervor will fall off. Followed constantly, he is no more free than when in prison, but talk to him or read his books and you will understand that he never knew what prisoner meant. He is free. Jesus dwells in him...and he who the son of man sets free is free indeed.

I see a sign held high by one of the Sacramento marchers. It says, "UNCLE SAM...JESUS WANTS YOU."

While some people in America are shaking their heads and counting the days until 1984, others, like the thousands in Sacramento, are too busy counting their brothers and sisters to notice what year it is. Wasn't yesterday 33 A.D.?? And isn't tomorrow Heaven?? And isn't today wonderful? I've never felt so free!

As a young dude I listened, I listened with a thirst To the Devil's distortion, at its musical worst He coaxed me toward hating my Mom and my Dad.

As the record turned, the indoctrination was sad Hate your country! Hate your Mama; she doesn't understand Hate your ol' man; he supports this filthy land.

Seduce that young girl with booze and with drugs Rip up the flag; let's listen to the fugs Run away from home; hit the road, hit the road.

Listen man, listen, and I'll program you more Listen little girl, and you'll be a wasted whore So cold, so very cold.

Drop a red and a yellow It's really mellow, young fellow Turn on a friend.

Uppers and downers, feed your head A hallucinogenic roller-coaster Take some hash to bed.

Meditate man! It's groovy up here Love and Peace. Drop a tab...

The big city's dirty, the gutters are full I wish I had a blanket...made of wool It's a lonely world if nobody cares.


Flashy car, and his manners are nice This dude will fix you, if you have the price Look into his eyes!




In a reply, which was printed along with Hoyland's letter in the British underground weekly, "The Black Dwarf," Lennon said very perceptively:

"He (Jesus) did not need anyone to tell Him what people were like; He understood human nature ... Jesus said, 'Without me you can do nothing.'"






