ELECTRONIC BOOKS

McKee Library provides access to electronic books during the physical library closure.

McKee Library's vast collection of electronic books is available at any time via the library's search bar or on our Electronic Books webpage.

Searching for Electronic Books

Search over 100,000 eBooks through McKee Library's homepage. Begin by searching for your keyword(s), subject, title, or author in the search box and selecting the magnifying glass.

On the left side of the search results page, you will see a group of filters under the heading "Tweak Your Results". First filter by Resource Type "Books", then filter by Subject "Electronic Books".

To view the eBook, click on the

"Available Online" link beside the image of the book on the search results page. If there are several options to obtain the book online, you will be brought to another page to choose from one of the available options. If there is only one option, you will be brought directly to the eBook.

VIRTUAL TUTORING

Writing Center and Tutoring Center appointments continue online.

The Writing Center and Tutoring Center will continue to provide online tutoring this summer. Students will create appointments using our online scheduler, <https://southern.mywconline.com>. Tutors will use Zoom for their appointments.

Since the move online at the end of March, the Writing Center and Tutoring Center tutors have held 770 appointments. Of those who completed a survey after their appointment, 99% rated the session "good" or "excellent." Here are several of the comments provided about the tutoring sessions:

DYNAMED

DynaMed is a point-of-care tool for health sciences students and health care professionals. It publishes clinically organized topics which are continuously updated as new information indicates a need for change in practice. Content ranges from comprehensive reviews of diseases, conditions, and abnormal findings to highly focused topics on evaluation, differential diagnosis, and management. Topics can be browsed by over thirty specialties, ranging from the topic allergy to the topic urology, or searched by keyword.

Drug and laboratory monographs developed and maintained by IBM Micromedex are also

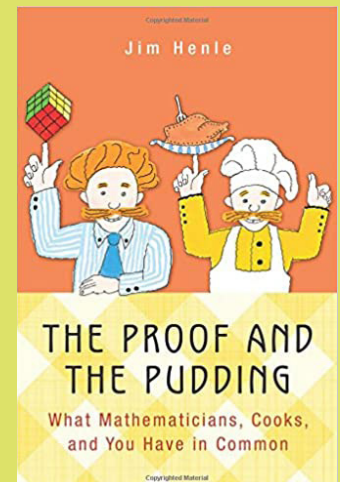
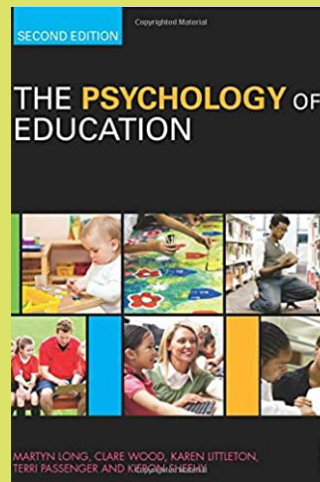
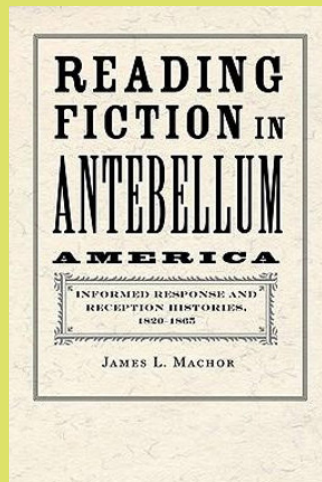
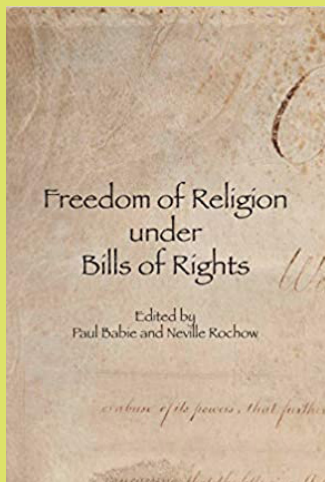
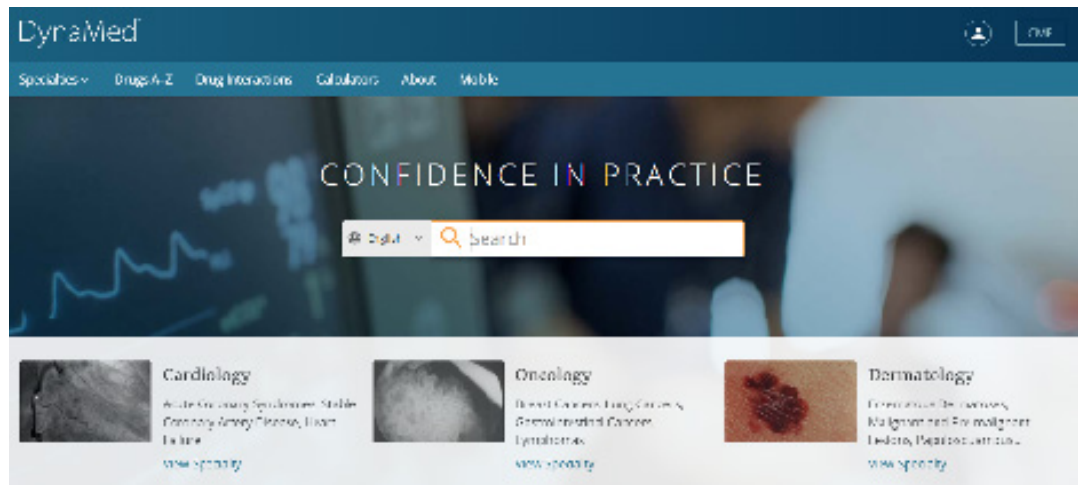
included. In addition, there is a drug interaction database that you can use to search for potential interactions of two or more drugs. Moreover, there are over a hundred clinical calculators, including medical equations,

clinical criteria, decision trees, statistical calculators, and units & dose converters.

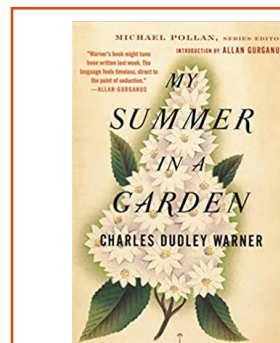

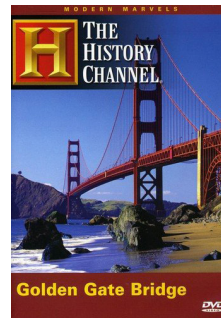

Southern's first yearbook, *The Southland*, was published in 1923. Seen here are selections from the 1927 yearbook.

There were no yearbooks published from 1931 through 1937. The yearbook's name was changed to *The Triangle* in 1938. It received its current name, *Southern Memories*, in 1945. The Southern Memories (1952 to present) yearbooks have not yet been digitized.
