MY NAME IS NOUREDDIN SALEHI;

IN IRAN, BY TRADITION, MOST MEN AND WOMEN HAVE TWO NAMES:

THE OFFICIAL NAME THAT IS FORMALLY RECORDED ON ALL GOVERNMENT LETTERS AND DOCUMENTS OF THE BUREAUCRATS' OFFICE.

AND A SMALLER NAME WHICH IS USED BY FAMILY MEMBERS, CLOSE FRIENDS, RELATIVES, AND LOCALS PEOPLE .

MY HOME COUNTRY WAS IRAN, BUT I HAD TO ESCAPE.

I WAS IN PRISON FOR 21 MONTHS WHERE I WAS TORTURED AND BEATEN -ALL BECAUSE I WROTE A BOOK QUESTIONING THE KORAN:

MY STORY WILL HELP YOU UNDERSTAND WHY I MUST SHARE WITH YOU.

MY STORY IS ONE YOU NEED TO KNOW, BUT I WAS TOO AFRAID TO SHARE IT WITH YOU UNTIL NOW

- •I became a United States citizen in 2018.
- As a citizen in the U.S., I have the freedom of speech, but I cannot let go of the fear that if I speak my mind, I may still be jailed.
- I am constantly worried. I love my new country, but it is hard to let go of the fears that shaped me for over 30 years.

Hamid Sadeghi has been a refugee in Greece for more than five years, and from the very first time he entered the country, he legally introduced himself to the asylum office and was recognized as a refugee after examining his initial case.



IF I AM NOW FREE, WHY DID I SEW MY LIPS TOGETHER?

A very mild form of punishment in Iran

My family and other Iranian brothers and sisters are not free. They are trapped in a country where they must follow the rules of the government and are not allowed freedom of expression.

You must hear me through my closed lips to understand the situation and why many Iranians may be an enemy of the U.S. – but not of their making. During this time, he was given a red card by the Refugee Agency for five years, with a scroll on his back that he could only cross the street and he can't even go to another city. He was held captive in the city like a hostage.

THE REALITIES OF LIVING IN A DICTATORIAL COUNTRY

Dictatorships control all the affairs of the country and censor all media and visual communications.

- The citizens of Iran have no right to tell the truth because the leader and his assistants do not allow them.
- Many people Iran do not have the right to worship their religious beliefs. Gatherings and gatherings based on their religious beliefs are illegal, and police and government officials arrest, imprison, and torture them.
- They are suppressing the people by using tricks and deceptions as an Islamic country in the name of the Islamic religion and forcing the citizens to follow it.
- They portray themselves and the country well in the media, but they are a real dictator and an oppressor.
- They paint the U.S. as an enemy, which is why it is easy to see why there is hatred for Americans and what they stand for, which is freedom.
