


H Index

Meaning: The *h*-index is an author-level metric that attempts to measure both the productivity and citation impact of the publications of a scientist or scholar. The *h*-index is defined as the maximum value of *h* such that the given author/journal has published *h* papers that have each been cited at least *h* times. (source: Wikipedia)


Web of Science: Make a search by author.

H Index - Manual calculation


Order the publication, from most to least cited. Number them and identify which number coincides with the number of citations received by one of the publications listed. This number is the h index of an author.




