
San Luis Obispo's Natural Café is one of nine scattered around California, yet it still manages to maintain a local feel.


General manager Jennifer Stuckey cites regular customers as the restaurant's greatest asset. "We have lots of regular customers that make it feel like we're our own little family here," she said.
