




Background of Project

- Working collaboratively with Morgan Mrozek and Danielle Silverman,
- Our lesson plan was focused on Social Studies, specifically, cultural celebrations.
- We focused on New Year
 Celebrations in several different southeast Asian countries.
- We used iMovie as our main tool, instructing students to research their assigned country, and present three facts, as well as visual representations.



The TPACK FRAMEWORK

- Three primary forms of knowledge: Content (CK), Pedagogy (PK), and Technology (TK)
- Content- extensive research on the countries and their corresponding traditions.
- Pedagogically-we had to take into account our grade level, and think of the best way to present the material to them,
- Technological content knowledge -We needed to know the ins and outs of iMovie
 - Helped us to determine which technology tool was best equipped for the particular goal of our lesson.
- Technological pedagogical knowledge, we understood how taking a digital resource, websites in this case, and asking students to revamp it into another digital form, such as iMovie, changed the way students would learn.



The 4 C's

- 1. Creativity students turned the facts they found through research into a multimedia product using the App iMovie.
- 2. Critical thinking students read the presented facts, did analyses, and figured out which traditions were most important to include in their iMovie
- 3. Communication students needed to discuss, negotiation and execute their lessons through working with partners and thus practice public speaking skills.
- 4. Collaboration students also needed to work together in the whole process to create the iMovie.



Learning Objectives

1. During the practice time, the students will work in their groups to integrate visual information into their iMovie project.

2. At the end of the activity, the students will have created an original work using the digital resources provided (websites).




