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# Methodological Proposal of a 2Gen Approach to Treating Trauma for Mothers with Substance-Use and Their Children

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
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


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## **OBJECTIVE**

Adverse environments, like exposure to parental substance abuse, are detrimental to the health and wellbeing of **parents** *and* **children**<sub>4</sub>. In 2016, 18 million children experienced one or more family stressor<sub>4</sub>.



Experiencing trauma through adversity can lead children and adults to develop PTSD<sub>2</sub> and negative lifelong symptoms that persist across generations<sub>2</sub>. It is vital for treatments to address the concerns for **both** children and adults. But there is **no** current therapeutic framework where parents and children have equal importance in therapy<sub>1</sub>

This study describes a methodological plan to further develop and pilot an innovative **2Generational (2Gen) treatment modality.** A 2Gen approach treats parents and children simultaneously in a concurrent group format to better outcomes for *all* family members<sub>3</sub>.




## PROPOSED METHOD

#### **PARTICIPANTS & RECRUITMENT**

- > Participants = 12 adult women with their children
- ➤ Recruitment from **Gaudenzia Kindred House**: a residential treatment facility for women with substance abuse issues and their children in West Chester, PA.
- > Flyers with treatment start date and basic information will be provided to the Kindred House.
