on board the good *Schooner* called the *Clara Watson* whereof  
*Albion Gray* is Master, for the present voyage, now lying in the  
Port of *Belvidere* and bound for *Brooklyn N.Y.* To say:  
*20 set Basin Stone & pieces to the set*

being marked and numbered as in the margin, and are to be delivered in like good order and  
condition, at the aforesaid Port & *at the Washington Garden* (the  
danger of the Seas only excepted,) unto *Attn. Colvin*  
or to Assigns, he or they paying Freight for the said Goods,  
*Five Dollars*  
with *out* Primage and Average accustomed....IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the  
Master of the said vessel hath affirmed to *three* Bills of Lading, all of this tenor and date,  
one of which being accomplished, the others to stand void.
