Mr. Hester

Mr. Washburn

wishes me to make out a bill of the
board which I have done I make it
out to be from the time they enlisted
to the time they started 238 days being
making \$83.20 allowing \$2.50 per week for board
and care total me they allow for 1000
we came on the 19th of July you will
find it to be so, I think
the Commr also wishes me to make
out every bill of expense of getting up
the Board it was me 44 dollars
that is what money I paid out not
receiving my term any of this
regiment goes home I want to see
the same in the 9th regiment

I think I ought to have a name
before my name as of these students
when to be shown a thing they tell
me I have got to have a name
the same as Lieutenant - to
show my name as Leader of
Reformed Band of 12 I was
I was soon as you read my name
I am yours respectfully
