Senall B. Bonden fried the Reft may 13th 1861 at Hillett Point Portland. Was not sworn in at Bangor. He Red no bounty o has reed no pay, from the State or Year Soverment. He was Killed at Bull Run puly 21, 1861 + was a good Joldier. So says Capt Filder of Co B. His relating are at Castine.

I wish to Call your attention to the foot that Frederice Parady of Co. K 20th legiment maine Nots was onlisted at old Jone by S. W. Hoskins pely 30 1861 started from Banger pely 4th 1861 treed no bounty - Can it be avanged to have his bounty paid, over to his wipe at old Journ if so, please have it done - through the Selectmen of the Town or some responsible citizen. If it cannot be done there please have his bounty paids to him here Parady is doing duty had nothing to do in the revolt but grandly be eause he has not read bounty he says here stewers told him he could get it here.
