Camp Rice near Fort Corcoran Va
Arlington Heights Aug 18, 1861

Sir -

I send you descriptive list made up as far as we
have it -

Small P. Bonden joined the Regt May 13th 1861
at ~~Willetts Point~~ Portland - Was not sworn in at Bangor -
He recd no bounty & has recd no pay, from the State or
Genl. Government - He was killed at Bull Run July 21, 1861
& was a good Soldier - So says Capt Vilders of Co B. His relatives
are at Castine -

I wish to call your attention to the fact
that Frederic Parady of Co. K 2nd Regiment Maine Vols - was
enlisted at Old Town by S. W. Hoskins July 3rd 1861 started from
Bangor July 4th 1861 & recd no bounty - Can it be arranged
to have his bounty paid over to his wife at Old Town
if so, please have it done - through the Selectmen of the Town
or some responsible citizen - If it cannot be done there -
please have his bounty paid to him here - Parady is doing
duty - had nothing to do in the revolt - but grumbles because
he has not recd bounty - he says Genl Stevens told him he could
get it here -
