Augt. 14. 1861 Israel Washburn J. kov. of maine Me the undersigned Field Staff and Company officers attached to the 2nd maine Regiment. humbly pray your Excellency to use all possible and honorable means to Muster out of the United states Service and immediately order to mame this regiment, for the following reasons\_ Viz\_ 1st Since the late ongagement at stone Bridge, me have been punable to procure shoes or clothing of any description, while other regiments and those lately organized have been amply supplied. 2 nd Our encampment being located in an unhealthy position, many of our men are nondered unfit for service, and require recruiting -. 32 Opr ner recruits not having been thoroughly examined, more than one quarter of them, on account of physical inability must be discharged. 4th In consequence of a mis construction long existing in the regiment in regardo to their term of service, fifty eight privates, and four noncommissioned officers, have this day repused duty, and m consequence of saide disobedience, have, by order of General Scott Commander in-chief, been sent to the Day Tortuges, in the Spill of Mexico, on "detached service," there to serve until the Government deems it expedient to transfer them Northmard. Oring to the foregoing reasons, we trust our prayer may be granted - sincerely believing, that the above course vill hereafter prove best. for the interest and velfare of maine in the long" domestic struggle" non before ars.
