Halls Church Aug 16th 1861

Dear Sir

We leave this afternoon
for Fairfax - we are attached
to the Division under Gen.
Sylvester of Conn. The boys feel
well and are anxious to
be on the move, & I hope &
trust they will give a good
account of themselves.

The last Knapsacks sent
were very satisfactory to
the men. The last ones
sent were not properly
examined - a great many
of them are entirely unfit
for duty, & will have to be
sent back immediately.

Everything else satisfactory
