Sept. 30th, 1861

Fort Coreoran Va.

2nd Regt. Maine Volunteers

Sir

Lieut. Sumner P. Kettledge of
Company D having been taken prisoner, and
probably now in Richmond, you will please
immediately appoint Stephen D. Millett as 2nd
Lieut. to fill the vacancy. The enemy have
ignominiously retreated from this vicinity and our
troops are now in transit from Fort Coreoran
to Richmond &c. I expect to move forward tomorrow.
I am sorry that I have so small a command
and very much doubt the policy of sending from the
State new recruits when none of the old ones are
in number up to the Army Standard but the ball
rolls on and if a man don't want to be crushed
he must get out of its wake. When does Col. Woodard
leave with the Cavalry? In haste I remain,
