

The UMR Film Series for the fall semester will run from Aug. 29 to Dec. 5.

Seventeen films will be shown at 7 p.m. every Thursday in Miles Auditorium, Mechanical Engineering Building, on the UMR camnus

Admission to the films is by season ticket, which can be purchased for \$14, or by individual ticket, which can be purchased at the door for \$2

Films to be shown are:

-Aug. 29: "Desperately Seeking Susan," directed by Susan Seidelman with Madonna and Rosanna Arquette. Rated.PG-13. Released in 1985. This quick-paced adventure revolves around identity and mistaken identity — not unlike Shakespeare's "Midsummer Night's Dream."

—Sept. 5: "Rope,"

directed by Alfred Hitchcock with James Stewart. PG. 1949. Hitchcock's favorite film is also his rarest, most intriguing and unprecedented movie. "Rope's" title is taken from the murder weapon and loosely based on an actual murder.

—Sept. 12: "El Norte," directed by Gregory Nava with Zaide Gutierrez and David Villalpando. PG. 1983. This extraordinary odyssey

focuses on two young people seeking a better life as their world begins to crumble. They must first travel dangerous roads and cross heavily patrolled borders. Once in America, their troubles are not over. They are "illegals" and must live in constant fear of discovery. It's no fun being an illegal alien.

—Sept. 19: "Sugar Cane Alley," directed by Euzhan Palcy with Garry Cadenat and Darling Ligitimus. PG. 1983. Set in Martinique in 1931, the film paints a rich impasto of native life under French colonial rule, filtered through the coming-of-age of a sweet, opportunistic black boy learning to reconcile the value of his shantytown roots with the educational opportunities that beckon him to the big city.

—Sept. 26: "The General," directed by and starring Buster Keaton. G. 1927. Keaton's matsterpiece involves two great locomotive chases and a Civil War battle. Along with an excellent print of this classic film will be live piano accompaniment."

-Oct. 3: "Koyaanisqatsi," directed by Godfrey Reggio. G. 1982. "Dark Glow of the Mountains," directed by Werner Herzog. G. 1985. Breaking with narrative tradition, "Koyaanisquatsi" brings landscape and cityscape to the foreground in a meditation on progress and the supposed benevolence of technology. Music by Philip Glass. "Dark Glow of the Mountains" is a mystical portrait of Reinhold Messner, one of the world's foremost mountain climbers, who recently traversed Gasherbrum Peaks I and II in an unprecedented seven days.

—Oct. 10: "Educating Rita," directed by Lewis Gilbert with Michael Caine and Julie Walters. PG. 1983. Michael Cain stars in this warm-hearted, ingratiating comedy as an alcoholic and disillusioned academician who reluctantly undertakes the education of a brassy and uneducated hairdresser.

Oct. 15: "Macbeth," directed by Roman Polanski with Jon Finch. R. 1972. An absolutely stunning conversion of Shakespeare to film. It contains all the classic tragic elements of murder, guilt and revenge. (Note: This is a special Tuesday screening in Miles Auditorium.)

-Oct 17: "The Ballad of Narayama," directed by Shohei Imamura with Ken

Physical Facilities Department Enhances UMR

The physical facilities department at UMR is dedicated to "Providing the necessary services to maintain and enhance a physical environment that is conducive to academic instruction and research," according to Bob Marlow, director of physical facilities

He added that the department has been committed to these goals since its inception. "Today, however, the services required of physical facilities in pursuit of these objectives have expanded in size, scope and complexity," said Marlow.

UMR physical facilities now includes the following areas: building maintenance, custodial services, grounds maintenance, operation of the power plant, utility distribution, vehicle operations, engineering services, minor renovations and remodeling and support for special events on campus.

Marlow explained that physical facilities provides these various services through three sections — maintenance, support services and heating plant.

"The maintenance section, which is under the direction of Lowell Wynn, is the largest of these three and is responsible for providing the campus with building and grounds maintenance, custodial services, utility distribution and support of vehicle services, renovation and special events," he said.

"The people who work in this section include custodians, groundskeepers, prevention maintenance, specialists, carpenters, electricians, painters, plumbers,

refrigeration specialists, heavy equipment operators, mechanical trades specialists, auto mechanics and drivers," he added.

The support section is under the direction of Hugh Jesse, assistant director of physical facilities. He explained that "We provide support services to the campus in the following areas: construction estimating, planning, key control, departmental accounting, clerical services, facilities inventory data, renovation scheduling, drafting, field engineering services, purchase order contracting, operation of central control system and vehicle reservations

"These services are provided by engineering, drafting, clerical, secretarial, accounting, estimating and facilities analyst personnel," he added.

The heating plant section is under the direction of Larry Matson. "The function of this section is to provide, without interruption, the generation of steam, electricity, compressed air, soft water and distilled water for the campus," Marlow said.

"These utilities are supplied 24 hours a day, 365 days a year by stationary engineers, heavy equipment operators and maintenance and secretarial personnel," he added.

"By working together as a department we feel that we are able to provide an attractive campus environment and provide for the campus' needs in a number of technical areas," said
