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A STUDY OF MARKET SEGMENTATION IN HIGH-TECH STARTUP VENTURES Alan David Lish

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Abstract

Much has been written about the benefits of market segmentation. In fact, it provides the basis of most marketing strategies in larger firms. But while larger firms understand the benefits of market segmentation and put it into practice, many start-up firms seem to ignore or dismiss segmentation as an essential marketing strategy.
