FOREWORD

With the growth and increasing complexity of the State University System of Florida, a growing need has developed for a convenient and authoritative source of information with respect to the operations of the System and the individual universities. This FACT BOOK is designed to meet this need.

The publication is designed to answer questions most frequently asked by persons both inside and outside the University System. The FACT BOOK should be particularly helpful to members of the Legislature and to State agencies, as well as to the members of the Board of Regents and its staff and the university administrator, faculty member, student and parent.

The FACT BOOK contains pertinent information by institution and in summary form for the System regarding enrollment, degrees, programs, faculty salaries and facilities, as well as historical background on each of the nine universities. Comparative data on other states is provided where such material is available and pertinent.

In general, the data covers six years of historical data and, where appropriate, a six-years' projection. It is planned that the publication will be revised at least once each year so that the information will be as current as possible. Replacement sheets will be distributed at appropriate intervals and should be inserted in the book.

Supplementing the information contained herein will be the Fact Books, Catalogs, and the Faculty Handbooks of the individual universities.

This first effort is not intended to provide an exhaustive range of information, but it is hoped that with experience its contents can be expanded and refined. Suggestions as to modifications or additions will be appreciated, and should be addressed to the Director of the Management Information Systems, 107 West Gaines Street, Tallahassee.


