of our Colony of Tasmania and its Dependencies—To hold, exercise, and enjoy the said office and place during Our pleasure and his actual residence within Our said Colony—Together with all the rights, privileges, and advantages thereunto belonging and appertaining, in the full and most ample manner. Provided always that the said *Honorable Andrew Inglis Clark*, except in case of sickness or other incapacity, do execute the said office in his own person.

In Testimony whereof We have caused these our Letters to be made Patent, and the Public Seal of our said Colony and its Dependencies to be hereunto affixed.

Witness our trusty and well beloved *The Right Honorable Justice William J. Spence* and *James A. G. Bennett* Commanders of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George *Governors and Commanders in Chief in and over the Colony of Tasmania and its Dependencies*
at Hobart, in the said Colony, this *fourteenth* day of *April*
one thousand eight hundred and *ninety four*, and in the *fifty sixth* Year
of our Reign.
