Why is it important to check your browser before logging in?

To make sure you will not encounter problems with incompatible technologies during the course. Uploading files and assignments are particularly prone to problems with unsupported browsers, and it is much harder for your tutors to support you if you access the course using an unsupported browser.

Your browser-check results

If your results are all green ticks, you are using a supported browser, and can go ahead and log in.

Failed browser test
