

What Worries ME About Placement!



- Financial Constraints
- Placement Family Unfriendliness
- Time Impositions
- Knowledge and Skills Unpreparedness
- Intra-professional Relationships
- Peer Support
- Student Responsibilities

What to expect on industry placement



What aspects of the session was most useful for Nursing?

Metropolitan

- Discussion of personal and academic challenges;
- Prompting further considerations into being prepared for placement;
- Talking about potential problems and identifying solutions.

Regional

- What to expect on clinical placement;
- Opportunity to ask lots of questions;
- Peer mentor/ student advice;
- Helped with feelings of worry, stress, frustration and anxiety/ sense everyone in the same boat.



What aspects of the session was most useful for education students?

- Presentation by peer mentor good tips and lots of reassurance;
- List of support services available;
- How to deal with fears and anxiety;
- The open ended question and answer sessions;
- The open forum style allowing students to discuss their worries and feelings openly.





Name action plans you intend to put into place before Clinical Prac.

Metropolitan

- Working on assertiveness and communication techniques;
- Time management;
- Evaluating how to respond to your buddy in a difficult situation;
- Preparation.

Regional

- Early planning and organisation of workload assessment prac's;
- Save money or increase earnings to prepare for prac;
- Organise family routines, commitments;



Name action plans you intend to put into place before prac – education students

- Contacting placement school;
- Organise/finish assignments prior to 4 week prac;
- Check out QUT Work Integrated Learning space;
- Provide a stress free time for myself;
- Plan meals ahead;
- Talking to peers about ideas to prepare/support one another.



The Financial Hardship of Uni

- >70% have some form of paid employment
- >40% working >20 hours/week
- >44% have a student loan
- >60% of students have children 2 on average
- >28% have children between 1-10 years of age

>70% live on a weekly income of <\$350

The Uni-Placement Conflict

Finding time to Complete Uni Assignments	39%
Being out of My Depth	37%
Finding time to reflect on placement learning	33%
Meeting extra costs of placement	31%
Finding time to for Placement Tasks	38%
