

DISTINGUISHED VISITORS

During the past month the School has been visited by several distinguished visitors representing various commands and foreign countries. Among them are the following:

The Superintendent and his staff, Iranian students and their wives, were visited by Captain A. Fouroghizadeh, Iranian Navy, Iranian Embassy, Washington, D. C. on 27 April 1976.

The Honorable William K. Brehm, Assistant Secretary of Defense for Legislative Affairs, addressed the Flag/General Defense Management Systems Course on Thursday, 29 April 1976.

Captain George O'Donnell, USN, Assistant Commander, Naval Intelligence Command for Resource Management visited the School on 28-30 April 1976, to discuss Postgraduate Support of the NAVINTCOM efforts to develop a comprehensive intelligence training and education plan for the Department of the Navy.

On 4 and 5 May 1976 Lieutenant General Sir David Willison, KCB, OBE, MC; Ministry of Defense, United Kingdom, addressed the faculty and students of the Naval Intelligence and National Security Affairs Curricula.

The speaker for the Aviation Safety Officer Graduation Ceremony on 7 May 1976 was Commander Larry Zbitnew, Canadian Forces.

Major General Frank J. Simokaitis, USAF, Commandant Air Force Institute of Technology, Dr. Faiman, Colonel Kelley, USAF, and Captain Garber, USAF, met with the Superintendent, RADM Linder, and his staff, on 5-7 May 1976 to discuss Graduate Education.

The Financial Management Curriculum Review was conducted on 11-12 May 1976, with Captain George Zeberlein, SC, USN (OP-924) and other interested staff in attendance.

The Naval Postgraduate School was pleased to be visited on 14 May 1976 by <u>Dr. Clement Chang</u>, President, Tamking University and Deputy Speaker of the Taipei City Council. He was escorted by Dr. Peter C. C. Wang, of the NPS Department of Mathematics.

The review of the Electronic Warfare Systems Technology Curriculum was conducted May 17 and 18, 1976. Distinguished members of this review team were: Captain J. W. Akins, USN, COMNAV ELEXSYSCOM (Elex-095), Captain R. F. Dreesen, USN, COMFEWSG; Captain J. L. Krumwiede, USN, OP-351; Dr. Frank Shoup, CNA Analyst; Mr. R. M. Ottensmeyer, CINCPACFLT (Code 02E); Mr. C. M. West, CNET (N-132), and Miss Joan Rose, COMNAVELEXSYSCOM (Elex-902R). Commander P. S. Roder, USN, NPS, and Professor D. B. Hoisington, NPS, coordinated this curriculum review.

Mr. Raymond Harrison, Head Career Management Division, of the Office of Civilian Manpower Management, visited the Naval Postgraduate School on 17 and 18 May 1976 to discuss the NPS Academic Programs available to the Navy's Civilian Employees.

An on-site review of the School's <u>Civilian Personnel Management Program</u> was conducted by representatives of the Western Field Division of the Office of the Civilian Manpower Management and of the Chief of Naval Education and Training during the period 17-26 May 1976.

Mr. James S. Campbell, Special Assistant for Systems Integration to the Assistant Secretary of the Navy (Research and Development) was at the Postgraduate School on 20 May 1976 for an orientation visit.

Major General Hector Vidal Galarza, Director, Peruvian Air Ministry and members of his official party, met with the Superintendent, Naval Postgraduate School, and his staff, on 21 May 1976 to discuss educational matters. Discussions were also held with the Peruvian students attending the Naval Postgraduate School.

FACULTY PROFESSIONAL ACTIVITIES

Associate Professor James K. Arima, Department of Operations Research and Administrative Sciences, presented a paper entitled "Measuring the Fit between Person and Equipment" at the Annual Meeting of the Western Psychological Association held in Los Angeles, California, 8-11 April 1976.

Associate Professor James K. Arima, in addition to the above, has been elected a Fellow of the Inter-University Seminar on Armed Forces and Society, an international organization concerned with the development and dissemination of research on military institutions, civil-military relations, war, and peace-keeping.

Professor T. Sarpkaya, Mechanical Engineering Department, presented a paper titled "In-Line and Transverse Forces on Cylinders in Oscillatory Flow at High Reynolds Numbers" at the Offshore Technology Conference held in Houston, Texas, on 3-6 May 1976. On the convergence of an algorithm for rational Chebyshev approximation. Rocky Mountain J. of Math 6 (1976) 227-236.

Abstract: An algorithm for rational Chebyshev approximation based on computing the zeroes of the error curve was investigated. At each iteration the proposed zeroes are corrected by changing them toward the abscissa of the adjacent extreme of largest magnitude. The algorithm is formulated as a numerical solution of a certain system of ordinary differential equations. Convergence is obtained by showing the system is asymptotically stable at the zeroes of the best approximation. With an adequate initial guess, the algorithm has never failed for functions which have a standard error curve.

In-line and Transverse Forces on Cylinders in Oscillatory Flow at High Reynolds Numbers. Proceedings of the Offshore Technology Conference, OTC-2533, pp. 95-108, May 1976.

Abstract: The paper presents the results of an extensive experimental investigation of the in-line and transverse forces acting on smooth and rough circular cylinders placed in oscillatory flow at Reynolds numbers up to 700,000, period parameters up to 150, and relative roughnesses from 0.002 to 0.02. The drag and inertia coefficients have been determined through the use of the Fourier analysis and the least squares method. The transverse force has been analyzed in terms of its maximum, semi-peak-to-peak, and root-mean-square values. In addition, the frequency of vortex shedding and the Strouhal number have been determined.

Canonical Methods in the Solution of Variable-Coefficient Lanchester Type Equations of Modern Warfare. Operations Research, Vol. 24, No. 1, January-February 1976, pp. 44-69.

Abstract: This paper develops a methematical theory for solving deterministic, Lanchester-type, 'square-law' attrition equations for combat between two homogeneous forces with temporal variations in fire effectivenesses. It gives a general form for expressing the solution of such variable-coefficient combat attrition equations in terms of Lanchester functions, which are introduced here and can be readily tabulated.

Abstract: The formation of discontinuities within internal gravity waves in a rotating Boussinesq atmosphere is investigated with a numerical model. The motion is bounded between two rigid horizontal boundaries, and heating and friction are neglected. Special sinusoidal initial conditions are used. The equations are integrated for a range of values of the initial Rossby (Ro) and Froude (Fr) numbers. Discontinuities are found when the following conditions are satisfied: Fr≥ 0.2 and Ro≥ 0.2. These results are substantially different from those obtained for a one-layer fluid with a free upper surface.
