

### Third-Country Nationals as % of total population (in the country and in the EU)

The bars show the number of people residing in the country who have the citizenship of neither the reporting country nor any other EU-27 Member States, or the UK. This is shown as an absolute number (right-hand side) and as a share of the total population (within the bars). Data covers the last four years. The yellow percentages indicate the share of Third-Country Nationals over total population in the EU-27.

The chart shows the types of first residence permits issued annually over the last four years. The reasons for issuing permits are Remunerated activities (referred to as 'Work'), Family, Education and Other. The group 'Other' includes Refugee status and subsidiary protection; Humanitarian reasons; Residence only; Unaccompanied minors; Victims of trafficking in human beings; and Other reasons not specified. Eurostat 'migr\_resoth' dataset provides this disaggregation. Please note that due to a later publication date by the source, data covers an earlier four-year period.

The percentages on the top of each bar show the share of asylum applications over the population both in the country and in the EU-27 (in yellow).

# Top 5 nationalities of annual number of first-time asylum applications: number of applications and % of total first-time annual applications

The chart shows the top five nationalities of people who have lodged applications for asylum in the country.

The top five nationalities are sorted top-down by decreasing number of first-time asylum applications. The number of annual applications per nationality and the share of these over the total annual applications in the Member State are shown.

Different colours are randomly associated with different nationalities; as a result, it might happen that two nationalities share the same colour.

If more than one nationality occupies the fifth position, only one is displayed (following an inverse alphabetical order).

### Number of first-instance asylum decisions by outcome (% of total decisions)

The chart shows the number (and share) of first-instance decisions on asylum applications in the Member State by outcome. It shows this for the last four years. It also shows the total number of decisions taken (right side of the bar). The possible outcomes are: 'Geneva convention status' (blue); 'Subsidiary protection' (light blue); 'Humanitarian protection' (cyan); and 'Rejected application' (grey). If an outcome is not available in the Member State or no decisions have resulted in that outcome, this is not displayed in the legend.

### Top 5 nationalities of annual number of first-instance decisions: number of decisions (% of total decisions in the country) and % of positive outcome

The chart shows the five nationalities with the highest number of asylum decisions in the country, each year for the last four years. The number of decisions taken for each nationality are reported on the right of the bar. This is shown as an absolute number and as a share of the total number of decisions taken in the country in the year.

The outcome of the decision (positive or negative) is indicated by the colours and by the percentages in the relevant part of the bars (positive decisions only).

If more than one nationality occupies the fifth position, only one is displayed (following an inverse alphabetical order).

The bars show the share of asylum applications lodged by Unaccompanied Minors over the total number of asylum applications lodged in the country during the same year. The yellow marker shows the share for the EU-27.

### INTEGRATION

The chart is divided into three subtopics, each described by two indicators. The value of the indicator [as %] is given for 'Nationals' (i.e. citizens of the Member State) and Third-Country Nationals – 'TCNs', i.e. citizens of non-EU-27 countries nor reporting country. The yellow marker shows the value of the same indicator for the EU-27. All values are relative to the last year available for both the EU and Member States.

The chart shows the number of people usually residing in the country and i) who are not considered as nationals by any State under the operation of its law ('Stateless' in blue); ii) who are not citizens of the reporting country nor of any other country, but who have established links to that country which include some but not all rights and obligations of full citizenship ('Recognised Non-Citizens' in light- blue); or iii) whose citizenship is unknown ('Unknown citizens' in dark blue); in a given year over the last four years.

The yellow marker indicates the share of TCNs who have acquired citizenship in the EU the same year.

### BORDERS, SCHENGEN AND VISAS

### Lodged short stay Visa applications (% of Schengen)

The chart shows the number of short stay visas annually applied for in the Member State's consulates around the world for the last four years. For Schengen countries, short stay visas include uniform visas (entitling the holder to stay in the territories of all Member States for a period of maximum 90 days within 180 days and that may be issued for a single entry or multiple entries (MEVs)), visas with limited territorial validity (LTVs), and airport transit visa (ATVs). The percentage on top of each column represents the share of these applications over the total number of applications lodged in consulates of the EU Member States that are part of the Schengen area. Please note that the Member State whose consulate receives the visa application may be different from the Member State of main destination.

Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus and Romania do not yet issue uniform Schengen visas. For these Member States, the figures refer to national short-stay visas.









# Top 5 nationalities of annual number of first-instance decisions: number of decisions (% of total decisions in the country) and % of positive outcome







Unaccompanied Minors as % of first asylum applications (in the country and in EU)










Top 5 nationalities by number of citizenship acquisition in 2018: absolute number and % of total acquisitions in the country by Third-Country Nationals


















Top 5 nationalities by number of citizenship acquisition in 2018: absolute number and % of total acquisitions in the country by Third-Country Nationals










Top 5 nationalities by number of citizenship acquisition in 2018: absolute number and % of total acquisitions in the country by Third-Country Nationals

















Top 5 nationalities by number of citizenship acquisition in 2018: absolute number and % of total acquisitions in the country by Third-Country Nationals
















# Top 5 nationalities of annual number of first-instance decisions: number of decisions (% of total decisions in the country) and % of positive outcome




Third-Country Nationals resettled: absolute number and as % of total resettled in EU





Unaccompanied Minors as % of first asylum applications (in the country and in EU)






Top 5 nationalities by number of citizenship acquisition in 2018: absolute number and % of total acquisitions in the country by Third-Country Nationals








Lodged short-term Visa applications in top 5 consulate countries (% of total app.s)



Top 5 nationalities by number of citizenship acquisition in 2018: absolute number and % of total acquisitions in the country by Third-Country Nationals





















Unaccompanied Minors as % of first asylum applications (in the country and in EU)









Top 5 nationalities by number of citizenship acquisition in 2018: absolute number and % of total acquisitions in the country by Third-Country Nationals




Lodged short-term Visa app. (% of Schengen)










Number of first-instance asylum decisions by outcome (% of total decisions)




# Top 5 nationalities of annual number of first-instance decisions: number of decisions (% of total decisions in the country) and % of positive outcome





Unaccompanied Minors as % of first asylum applications (in the country and in EU)










Third-Country Nationals who have acquired citizenship as a share of total Third-Country Nationals (in the country and in the EU) and in absolute number








