Recreation Board for misconduct or neglect of duty.

- c. Vacancies occasioned by removal, resignation or otherwise, shall be reported to the Council, and shall be filled in like manner as original appointments, except that the term of office is restricted to the unexpired term of office. No director of the Board shall receive compensation as such.
- d. It is hereby declared the policy of the City Council that one member of the Park and Recreation Board shall always be a member of the Board of Education of the Reorganized School District of \_\_\_\_\_\_\_.

#### Section 3: OFFICERS: RULES AND POWER

The Park and Recreation Board shall, immediately after the appointment of directors, meet and organize by the election of one member as President, and such other officers as they deem necessary.\* The Board shall make and adopt such bylaws, rules and regulations for its own guidance and proceedings as may be expedient, not inconsistent with this ordinance and with sections 90.500 to 90.570 Missouri Revised Statutes, 1978.

\*Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer are appropriate offices.

#### Section 4: DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The Park and Recreation Board shall:

- a. Survey and make plans for the development and maintenance of facilities and activities for an adequate Municipal Park System.
- b. The Board shall have exclusive control of the expenditures of all money collected to the credit of the Park Fund, for the supervision, improvement, care, acquisition, and custody of the parks.
- c. All moneys received for such parks shall be deposited in the treasury of \_\_\_\_\_\_\_, Missouri, to the credit of the Park Fund and shall be kept separate and apart from all other moneys and accounts of the town/city of \_\_\_\_\_\_, Missouri and be drawn upon the proper officers of the town/city of \_\_\_\_\_\_, Missouri, upon the properly authenticated vouchers of the Park and Recreation Board.
- d. The Park and Recreation Board shall have power to appoint a suitable person to take charge of said parks and necessary assistants, if required for said person, and to fix their compensation. The Board shall also have power to remove such appointees for misconduct or neglect of duty, and shall, in general, carry out the spirit and intent of sections 90.500 to 90.570

Revised Statutes in establishing and maintaining Public Parks.

#### Section 5: ANNUAL REPORTS

The Board of Directors shall present to the Town Council an annual report. Such report shall be presented at the first council meeting in May of each year and shall consist of:

- a. The condition of their trust as of the first day of May of that year.
- b. The various sums of money received from the park fund, and other sources.
- c. The sums of money expended by the Board and for what purposes.
- d. Such other statistics, information, and suggestions as the Board may deem to be of general interest.
- e. All such portions of said Report as related to the receipts and expenditures of money shall be verified by affidavits.
- \*f. Submit a proposed park and recreation budget for the coming year.
- \*g. Make recommendations for improving the park and recreation program and facilities.
- \*h. Submit an annual planned program for the use of the parks, recreation facilities and areas.
- \*Not explicit in the law, but highly recommended.

#### Section 6: PRIVATE DONATIONS

The Park and Recreation Board shall be held as special trustee for all donations of money, personal property, or real estate for the benefit of such park, whenever such donations are accepted according to the terms of the deed, gift, devise, or bequest of such property.

Section 7: All ordinances, resolutions or parts thereo in conflict with the provisions of this ordance are hereby repealed. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after this day of 19
