









Rate ratios compared to White, Non-Hispanic	Black	Hispanic or Latinx
Cases	2.6x higher	2.8x higher
Hospitalizations	4.7x higher	4.6x higher
Deaths	2.1x higher	1.1x higher

Change in Unemployment Rate From February to September 2020 by Race and Ethnicity










I feel uncomfortable sharing my thoughts about racial inequity²⁶



I feel uncomfortable sharing my experience of grief or loss²⁶




I feel like I can't talk about the impact current events are having on me or people in my community²⁷


