**Prince Leopold as a Mason.**  
Prince Leopold was installed Master of the Lodge of Antiquity on the 25th ult. The Lodge itself is, with the exception of the Kilwinning, the oldest in the craft, and dates from immemorial antiquity.—The Prince's great-uncle, the Duke of Sussex, was Master of the Lodge for thirty-four years, and among the curiosities belonging to it are the trowels used by the Duke when laying foundation stones, among them being that of the Caledonian Asylum. Other relics date still further back. The mallets used was presented to the Lodge by Sir Christopher Wren, who was Master of the Lodge during eighteen years, and who initiated William the Third into Freemasonry. This mallet was used by Charles the Second to lay the foundation stone of St. Paul's Cathedral, and was made out of the wood of old St. Paul's. Another is a piece of stone dug up when laying the foundation stone of the Cathedral, and belonging to the Temple of Diana, which in the days when the Romans occupied Britain, stood on the site of the great cathedral of the city. The ceremony was an imposing one, and Prince Leopold expressed his extreme satisfaction in succeeding to a post which had been adorned by a distinguished member of his family.

**Latest News.**  
London, July 29.—There are 57,000 persons in the Durham collieries, the greater part of whom will be directly affected by Lord Derby's award as umpire reducing wages one and a quarter per cent in addition to the former reduction.

The cholera is abating at Cabul.  
The Colorado beetle has made its appearance in County Cork, Ireland.

London, July 29.—Kate Webster, convicted of the murder of Mrs. Thomas, her mistress, at Richmond, was hanged to-day in Wandsworth Prison. She confessed that she committed the murder and had no accomplices, either in the commission of the crime or disposal of the remains of the victim.

Parole had a practice gallop to-day and is reported thoroughly fit for the Goodwood cup race.  
The race at Goodwood to-day for the Richmond stakes, 2 year-olds, was won by Bender, the Adventurer colt second, Dora third, Lorillard's Papoues in sixth.

London, July 30.—A large portion of the wall of the import dock, East India docks, Blackwall, fell yesterday, carrying with it all the hydraulic cranes and quay sheds. The damage is estimated at £100,000.

**RUSSIA.**  
BERLIN, July 29.—There have been fresh disturbances in Siberia, near Kattowitz, at a mine on the Russian border. The miners were quitted by Russian gendarmes.

St. Petersburg, July 29.—American capitalists have offered to build a navy yard at Sebastopol for the construction and maintenance of a Russian volunteer fleet of cruisers.

St. Petersburg, July 29.—The assassin of Lieut.-Gen. Dronetz has been arrested. He is the same person who has been passing under the name of Platenoff, and committed other offences at Taganrog. He fired on the gendarmes, who arrested him.

Madrid, July 26.—The old women who threw a stone at the King when on his way to church is insane, and has been sent to an asylum.

Madrid, July 29.—The Spanish Government has signed a treaty of commerce with the Republic of Colombia.

The negotiations between Peru and Spain for a renewal of diplomatic relations are proceeding satisfactorily.

There is an unconfirmed rumor that at a Cabinet council, King Alfonso presiding, it was decided to abandon the project for a marriage between the King and the Austrian Princess.
