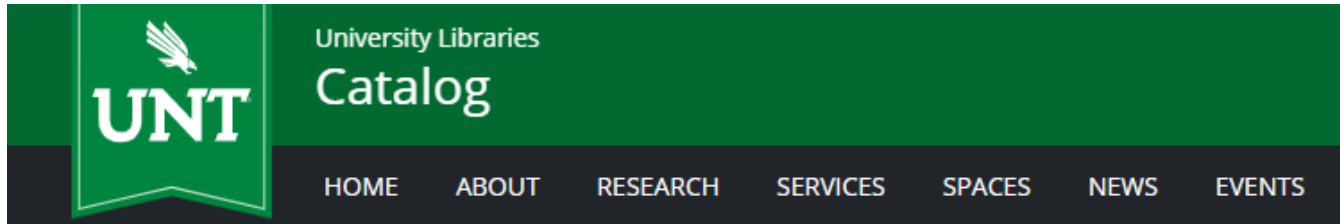

- Nearly 3 millions records
- Add about 100,000 records annually
- About 75% of new records come from vendor batch records
- 5 librarians handle about 65 different collections

# From where to obtain MARC records?

## E-Resource Vendor

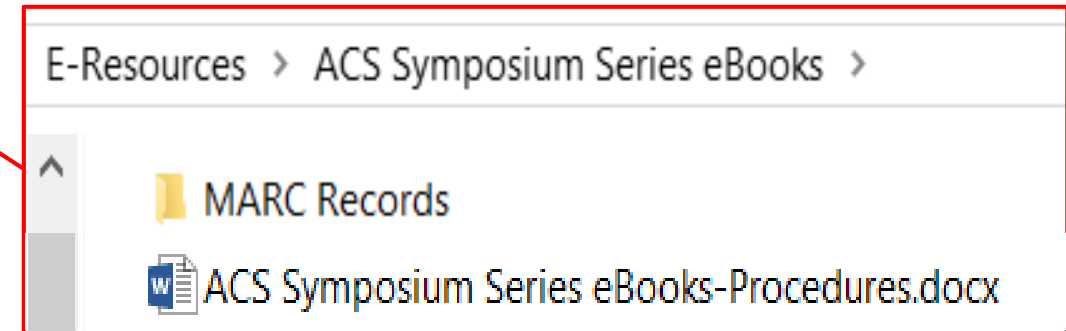
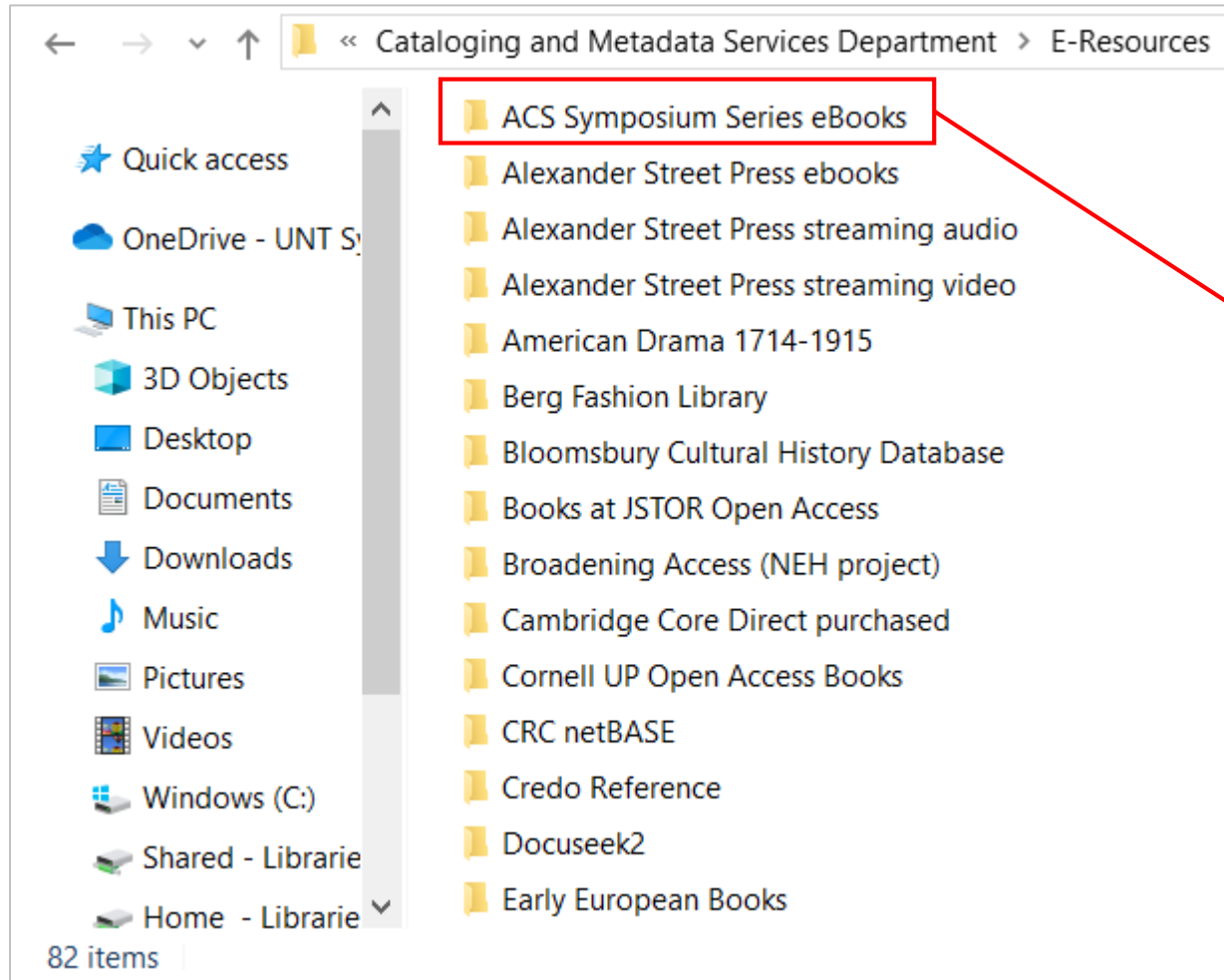
- Advantages:
  - “Free!”
  - Easy to download
  - Uniform and consistent
- Disadvantages:
  - Quality varies by vendor
  - Records downloaded from multiple locations that work differently

# From where to obtain MARC records?



- Advantages:
  - Customization
  - Frequency of updates determined by library
  - New, updated, and deleted WorldCat records are delivered
- Disadvantages:
  - Generally, requires OCLC cataloging subscription
  - Initial records take several days to be delivered
  - Title must have OCLC number

## Project Management Software

- Examples:
  - Trello, Jira, Basecamp, Freedcamp
- Advantages:
  - Use to assign tasks & set due dates
  - Regular tasks can be scheduled
- Disadvantages:
  - A long time to implement
  - Difficult to get buy-in

## Excel Spreadsheet

- Advantages:
  - Familiar software
  - Already on computer
  - Easy to use & customize
- Disadvantages:
  - No notifications

- Delete obsolete data
- Correct errors
- Supply missing information
- Insert local fields
