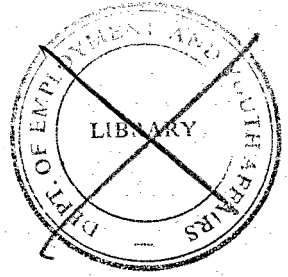

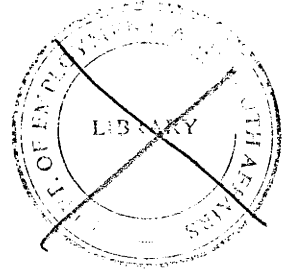

PREFACE

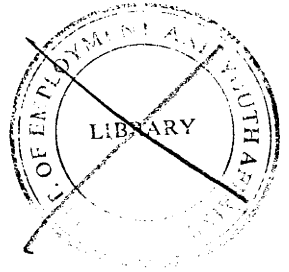
This is the fourth edition in a series of Handbooks of Trade Unions and Employees' Associations published by the Political Science Department, Research School of Social Sciences, of the Australian National University. The first edition, by the present authors, was published in 1970 and showed union membership as at June 1969. The second and third editions, by D.W. Rawson, were published in 1973 and 1977.

The earlier editions soon went out of print and have plainly served a need. Apart from their other content, the Handbooks have been the only attempt to list all trade unions known to exist in Australia. They have also provided information on the membership of unions; their registration under certain state and federal legislation; and their affiliation with the Australian Council of Trade Unions and its state branches and with the Australian Labor party. In this edition, as in the third, membership of each union is given by sex and by each state and territory.

We can fairly claim that the present edition is the best of the series. We have done all we could to obtain information from individual unions, large and small, and this information is more complete than in the past. In addition, the fact that the Handbooks now cover a period of ten years enables us to draw attention, in the Introduction, to some of the important changes in the composition of Australian unions which took place during that time.

As always, we owe a debt to the officials of the unions, of union federations and of the Australian Labor party who have provided us with the basic information for the Handbook. Federal and state government officials have again been most helpful in providing other material. For the preparation of the text we are indebted to Vance Merrill and Debbie Hill, of the Political Science Department.

INTRODUCTION

Trade unions are important organizations and we need as much information as we can get about them. This need applies quite as much to their own members and leaders as to others. There would have been general agreement about these propositions long before the first of these Handbooks was published in 1970, and since then the importance of unions has become, if anything, more obvious still. This does not mean that unions have thereby become more popular. Some of those who see them as more important than in the past are thankful for this fact, because they see trade unions as defending their members against increasing threats and challenges from governments and from their employers; but others see the unions' increasing importance as regrettable or as a danger.

It is no part of our present purpose to debate these broad and controversial matters. This Handbook, like its predecessors, aims merely to provide basic information about trade union membership. It sets out, to the best of our knowledge and ability, all the unions in Australia. It says how many members each union has, how these members are distributed between the various states and territories and, where this information is available, the number of men and of women that each contains. We indicate which unions are registered under state and federal legislation, especially the conciliation and arbitration Acts which operate at the federal level and in four of the states. The Handbook shows which unions are affiliated with the principal federation of trade unions, the Australian Council of Trade Unions (ACTU), and with each of the ACTU's state branches, which in most states are called Trades and Labor Councils. It shows affiliations with the largest and most important of the other central union bodies, the Council of Australian Government Employee Organizations (CAGEO), which covers unions of federal government employees. It also shows, as far as possible, which unions are affiliated with the Australian Labor party (ALP), the only party which has affiliated unions.

The Handbook continues to provide the only published information on unions and their membership which attempts to be complete. In the course of doing so, it also provides the only published list of unions. Each year the Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS) collects membership information from unions, and publishes overall figures showing total union membership divided by state or territory and by sex, and into various categories of size. These appear in the Bureau's annual bulletin Trade Union Statistics: Australia, which appears under Catalogue No. 6323.0. These figures are obviously of great value and authority, but they have severe limitations.

The Bureau obtains its figures from unions under the authority of the Census and Statistics Act. This imposes on unions a legal obligation to provide this information but also guarantees that it will be treated confidentially. The Bureau interprets this as meaning not only that it cannot reveal the size of any union but that it cannot even reveal which

organizations are included in its survey. Thus while Trade Union Statistics: Australia, December 1979, No. 6323.0, tells us that there were then, as the Bureau carefully puts it, 315 'reporting trade unions' in Australia, it does not tell us which organizations make up this total.

There are various other lists, published or publicly available, which list certain trade unions; but by their nature they do not attempt to be complete. These are lists of unions registered under arbitration legislation at the federal level and in some states; unions registered under Trade Union Acts in New South Wales and Western Australia; unions affiliated with the ACTU, with the state Trades and Labor Councils or CAGEO; and, in some states, unions affiliated with the ALP. While the Handbook notes these registrations and affiliations, it also includes unions which do not come under any of these categories.

There are unions not registered under the federal Conciliation and Arbitration Act, under state Trade Union Acts, or under state arbitration Acts; and not affiliated with the ACTU or with any of its branches or with the ALP.

There are particular difficulties in listing all unions in Victoria and Tasmania, where the Trade Union Acts are dead letters and where there are no state arbitration Acts.

In such circumstances we can never be sure that we have listed all unions. Depending upon the definition of the word 'union', an organization may be considered as a single union, several unions or not a union at all. Any such listing is bound to show some errors and omissions; but we have done our best and we are, of course, open to correction.

WHAT IS A TRADE UNION?

This initial question is not as easily answered as at first appears. Our principle has been to adopt the very extensive definition of a trade union which is followed by the ABS. The Bureau says:

For the purpose of these statistics a trade union is defined as an organisation, consisting predominantly of employees, the principal activities of which include the negotiation of rates of pay and conditions of employment for its members (ABS 1980:1).

This means that we include bodies which have minorities of members who work under contract, such as contract owner-drivers of trucks who may belong to the Transport Workers' Union, or sub-contractors in the building industry who may belong to the Building Workers' Industrial Union or other building unions. We do not, however, include bodies like the Australian Medical Association which, although it includes a minority of salaried doctors and sometimes represents

them in negotiating their conditions of employment, is predominantly made up of self-employed people.

Similarly, we include all bodies which regard the negotiation of conditions of employment as among their principal activities. Unions undertake a variety of other activities. Some are active and important forces in politics; some have important educational activities or are involved in the maintenance of professional standards; some conduct social welfare activities for their members. We have not regarded any such activity as either essential for a trade union or as disqualifying a body from being a trade union.

The one instance in which we have treated an association as a trade union in one place but not a trade union in others illustrates this distinction. The Australian Physiotherapy Association is a national body with professional and educational functions. In most states it is not involved in conditions of employment. Those of its members who are employees are represented by trade unions for these purposes; for example, by the Public Service Association of New South Wales. In Queensland, however, the situation is different. Here the Australian Physiotherapy Association has the same functions as in other states but in addition it represents its employee members in matters dealing with conditions of employment, and for this reason is registered as an industrial union under the state Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act. We therefore count the Queensland branch, but only the Queensland branch, of the APA as a trade union.

It will be seen that, although we use the phrase 'employees' associations' in our title, we do not make a distinction between 'trade unions' on the one hand and 'employees' associations' on the other. Our purpose is merely to indicate the breadth of the coverage which we have attempted and that we have included bodies which may not always be regarded as unions by their own members.

Because trade unions have been so broadly defined, they differ greatly among themselves and it is very necessary to distinguish between unions of different types. One of the main purposes of our Handbook is to make such distinctions possible. For example, if we are speaking of the role of 'the trade unions' within the ALP, we need to recall that not much more than half the total number of unionists belong to unions which are affiliated with the ALP. If we are speaking of the ACTU as representing 'the trade unions' we need to keep in mind that, although we are now speaking of a much larger proportion of unionists, of the order of 83 per cent, there are many important unions which are not part of the ACTU. If we say that 'the trade unions' included an increasing proportion of the workforce in the early 1970s but a slightly diminished proportion in the late 1970s, we need to remember that for many unions both of these tendencies were reversed. There were many unions which declined during the earlier period and many which gained in membership during the latter.

Some of these matters will be further discussed later in this introduction. The more general point, however, is that trade unions make up such a mixed bag of organizations that we need to know something about them individually. This Handbook, like its predecessors, is intended as a first step in that process.

If the broad definition of unionism is understood, and it is appreciated that it does not imply any attempt to treat a varied and rapidly changing body of men and women and their organizations as though they came within any single pattern, it is not likely to lead to difficulties or ambiguity. In some legal contexts, the term 'trade union' may refer only to organizations which are registered, or eligible for registration, under state Trade Union Acts, which will briefly be discussed below. However, this need not trouble us for most of the purposes for which this Handbook is likely to be used.

HOW MANY UNIONS AND UNIONISTS ARE THERE?

The Handbook lists 286 unions, with a total membership of 2807980. The latest ABS Bulletin says that in December 1979 there were 315 unions, with 2855100 members. The difference in total membership is 47120, or 1.7 per cent. There are a number of possible explanations for these differences. Much of the difference in total membership may be attributable to the fact that some of our figures for individual unions refer to December 1978 and others to December 1979. During this period, according to the Bureau, total union membership increased by 46800. Though, as explained, we cannot check our list of unions against the Bureau's, the difference in the number of unions seems due to two factors. Firstly, the Bureau appears to have included a number of very small unions not known to us. Its tables show 144 unions with less than 1000 members each, whereas this Handbook includes only 128 such unions. All such unions, according to the Bureau, comprise only 1.6 per cent of the total number of unionists. Secondly, we have treated nation-wide unions as single entities wherever possible, though they may instead be regarded as distinct state unions. In the case of the Australian Teachers' Federation alone, this reduces the number of unions listed by 6.

As this example indicates, determining the number of unions is not simply a question of obtaining complete information. There are respects in which the number of unions is a matter of opinion, or of definition.

Some of these dubious matters are no more than traps for young players. For example, the same union may be registered under different names in different states. In some cases this may be quite misleading. For example, there is a union registered under the federal Conciliation and Arbitration Act called the Amalgamated Society of Carpenters and Joiners of Australia. It has over 20000 members in several states, but none in Queensland. In Queensland, there is a union registered under the state Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act as the Amalgamated Society of Carpenters and Joiners and Bricklayers of Australasia, Queensland Branch. This is not a branch of the federal Amalgamated Society of Carpenters and

Joiners of Australia, despite the similarity of the names; but it is a branch of the federally-registered Building Workers' Industrial Union, which has a total over 47000 members in all states.

There are other cases in which a name may be misleading. The West Australian Locomotive Engine Drivers', Firemen's and Cleaners' Union is not, as its name might suggest, a completely independent union; it is the state branch of the Australian Federated Union of Locomotive Enginemen. On the other hand, the Hospital Employees' Union of Western Australia is a completely independent union, and not a branch of the Hospital Employees' Federation of Australia, which does, however, have a branch in Western Australia, quite separate from the Hospital Employees' Union. Similarly, the Food Preservers' Union of Western Australia is a separate union and not a branch of the Food Preservers' Union of Australia.

We have included all state branches under the title of the federal union. However, the Appendix lists all state branches known to us which are registered or are generally known under a title other than that of the federal union to which they belong.

Such examples, though confusing, at least have a definite correct answer in each case. Others may be seen as matters of opinion. The unions of government school teachers in all states except South Australia and Tasmania belong to the Australian Teachers' Federation which, with 125000 members, is the fourth largest union in Australia. It is affiliated with the ACTU under this title. It does not, and indeed cannot as the law now stands, appear on behalf of teachers in the state systems before federal arbitration authorities. Thus the state teachers' unions, under their various titles, undertake the work of negotiating conditions of employment for their members, either within state arbitration systems or through other more specialised machinery at the state level. The names of these state teachers' unions which are affiliated with the ATF are included in the Appendix. The South Australian Institute of Teachers and the Tasmanian Teachers' Federation are quite independent unions, and appear as such.

The limitation of the role of the ATF arises from a decision of the High Court in 1929 that teaching was not an 'industry' and therefore could not give rise to a dispute which could be considered by the federal arbitration authorities (See Sykes and Glasbeek 1972:387). A similar decision in 1970 which has been referred to as 'the absurd decision in Pittfield v. Franki' (Sorrell 1979:120) held that firefighting was also not an 'industry'. The significance of this for our present purposes is the uncertainty which follows as regards the fire fighting unions. Prior to the High Court's decision, the principal firefighters' unions in all states were in the process of forming an organization called the United Firefighters' Union of Australia (Rawson and Wrightson 1970:98,107). Since Pittfield v. Franki, the various unions have had to continue to operate at the state level, with the exception of the Federal Firefighters' Union, which is made up of employees of the federal government. The title United Firefighters' Union has come to be confined to Victoria and Tasmania and also to what is, in effect, a separate union in

Queensland. Elsewhere the firefighters' unions continue to operate under a variety of titles, and we have treated them also as separate unions.

We should also mention another complication arising from the scope of the federal Conciliation and Arbitration Act. Some of the employees who come within the Act are as surprising as some, like the firefighters, who do not. A variety of state public servants (not merely employees of state industrial undertakings like the railways) have successfully sought coverage under the federal Act. As such, they need to belong to a federally-registered union, although they may also belong to the 'ordinary' unions of state public servants, which in most states use the title Public Service Association. Thus we have not included the State Public Services Federation (the name of the federally-registered organization devised for this purpose) in our count, because virtually all its members will also be included under their state public service associations. Similarly, we have not included the Professional Officers' (State Public Services and Instrumentalities) Association because all its members also belong to state unions covering professional officers.

Though matters such as these are all too important for the leaders of the unions involved, they will not concern most of our readers. However, we include these explanations to indicate that we are not unaware of the legal and other complications raised by the apparently simple task of making a list of unions and their membership, and have done our best to grapple with them.

In general, our principle has been, wherever possible, to show members as belonging to a single federal union rather than to a number of state unions, even where the latter have, for some purposes, a separate legal existence. This may be one reason why our total number of unions is now significantly lower than that of the ABS. The Bureau's figure for the number of unions in 1978 rose from 279 to 316 due largely to the adoption of different methods of defining separate unions. This is a further illustration of how the number of unions may differ according to the methods used.

Discussion of the number of unions inevitably raises problems as to the number of unionists. In the case of the state public service organizations it is relatively easy to see where dual membership of unions exists and also to decide that it should not be included in the total of unionists. In these cases, the members belong to two very closely related bodies; or rather, to a single union which, for reasons of legal requirements, has found it convenient to take a dual form. The broader question of dual or multiple membership, where a single person may belong to two or more unions unrelated to each other and perhaps covering different occupations, is not so easily handled. In fact, it cannot be handled at all, and we can only say that it exists to an unknown, though probably minor, extent and produces some exaggeration of the total number of people who belong to unions.

There is no uniform practice among unions as to who are regarded as their current members. Some include only financial members. Others also include those whose fees are in arrears for varying periods or who have retired from work.

The distribution of union membership by state and by sex is subject to further uncertainties. Unions frequently keep no separate record of their membership in one or both of the territories (the Australian Capital Territory and the Northern Territory), and include these members with those in an adjoining state. In some cases a union with a few members in a particular state will also include these in the figures for a nearby state. Where possible, our tables for the individual unions indicate where this is done.

Distribution of membership between men and women cannot be stated with precision, since some unions no longer record the sex of their members. The adoption of equal pay for the same job classification has tended to remove one reason for noting the sex of members. The ABS frankly draws attention to this problem in the notes which accompany its figures, though the point could be missed by readers who noted only that these figures purport to show distribution by sex correct to the nearest hundred. However, this does not cast doubt upon the overall estimates of the ABS, which show a rapid increase in the proportion of unionists who are women. The proportion rose from 23.3 per cent in 1969 to 31.6 per cent in 1979. The ABS figures also show that this increase was due partly to an increase in the proportion of employees who were women and partly to an increased tendency for women employees to belong to unions. The larger unions which do not record the sex of their members are set out below.

Federated Liquor and Allied Industries Employees
Union of Australia. Membership 97514

Transport Workers' Union of Australia.
Membership 95087.

Royal Australian Nursing Federation.
Membership 39438.

Hospital Employees' Federation of Australia.
Membership 29482.

It is safe to assume that these unions have majorities of female members, though with significant numbers of males; except in the case of the Transport Workers' Union of Australia, where this position is reversed.

We are also unable to provide figures by sex for the Australian Teachers' Federation, since these are not available for New South Wales though they have been given for the other states in which the Federation operates. The ATF must have a majority of female members, though in this case the majority is relatively small.

If these assumptions are correct, five of the eight largest unions in Australia have majorities of female members. These are the Shop, Distributive and Allied Employees' Association (2nd); the Australian Teachers' Federation (4th); the Federated Clerks' Union of Australia (5th); the Federated Liquor

and Allied Industries Employees' Union of Australia (6th); and the Federated Miscellaneous Workers' Union of Australia (8th).

CHANGES IN UNION MEMBERSHIP

The annual figures of the ABS and its predecessor, the Commonwealth Bureau of Census and Statistics, (CBCS) enable us to follow fluctuations in union membership since 1913, while there are some less reliable estimates for earlier years since 1890. From them we can see changes in total membership; in membership in each state and among either sex; and also in the proportion of wage and salary earners who belong to unions. These figures are of great value and interest, though, because the Bureau's methods have been revised from time to time, the figures cannot be treated as being directly comparable over long periods. A revision which occurred in 1980 has resulted in the number of unions during the late 1970s being revised upward by about 12 per cent, while their membership has also been revised upward by about 1 per cent.

Such minor complications do not prevent our seeing general trends in union membership in the ABS figures. We can see, for example, that the proportion of employees who belonged to unions reached a peak in the early 1950s, being given as 61 per cent in 1954. There was then a decline to 1970, followed by an increase to 56 per cent, according to the methods now used by the Bureau, in 1975. From 1976 to 1979 this figure has been 55 per cent. We can also learn about changes in the proportions of male and female unionists and variations between union coverage in the different states.

Nevertheless, there may be changes in union membership which the Bureau's figures do not reveal at all. Until 1971, the CBCS published membership figures divided into industry groups. This was discontinued because the membership of some unions overlapped the boundaries of such industry groups. Since the Bureau was unable to publish the size of individual unions, this meant that, after 1971, it could say nothing which was relevant to the way in which union membership was related to different industries and occupations. Unions are not all of a piece. Conditions which foster the growth of some may bring about the decline of others. An overall appearance of stability, or of moderate change in some direction, may conceal a variety of marked changes in individual union membership which may largely cancel each other out when the figures are totalled but are not the less important for that.

The 1970s were a period in which changes of this kind took place. The membership of Australian unions changed much more than it is possible to detect from the ABS figures. These changes can only be seen if we consider the record of individual unions. Table 1 lists, in order of present size, those unions with a membership of more than 10000. Members of these unions comprised 83 per cent of all unionists in 1979. The table shows the per cent changes in membership since 1976, when the material for the previous edition of the Handbook was obtained; and also since 1969, the date of the figures used in the first edition.

*The membership of this union has been compared with the total membership, in 1969, of the unions which now comprise it.

It will be seen that there has been marked variation in the membership of individual unions. Over the longer period 1969-1979 these differences follow a clear pattern. This is shown in Table 2, where the unions are listed in order of the per centage increase in their membership during that time. Since total union membership, according to the ABS, increased by 27 per cent between 1969 and 1979, those unions which increased by more than that figure outstripped the overall growth of unions; while those which showed lesser increases, or actually lost numbers, fell behind it. To illustrate some of the ways in which differences in growth have affected the relative size of unions of different types, unions which are not affiliated with the ALP in any of the states of New South Wales, Victoria, Queensland or Western Australia have been underlined, while unions which were not affiliated with the ACTU in 1979 are marked with an asterisk. (The reason South Australian and Tasmanian affiliations with the ALP are not included is mentioned at pp. 17-18 below).

This table shows very clearly the uneven growth of union membership in terms of union affiliations. Of the 29 unions with 10000 or more members which grew more rapidly than unionism as a whole, only 12 were affiliated with the ALP. By contrast, all the 23 unions which grew less than unionism as a whole were affiliated with the ALP in one or more states. Of the rapidly-growing unions, 10 were also not affiliated with ACTU, 6 of these being unions of federal or state public servants.

These administrative distinctions reflected differences in the occupational character of faster-growing and slower-growing unions. Most of the faster-growing unions are made up of non-manual workers and are unions which have never affiliated with the ALP and have joined the ACTU, if at all, only during the past two years. However, not all the faster-growing unions are of this kind. Some of the most rapid growth, among unions which were already large, has affected unions of manual workers in the distributive or 'tertiary' industries - the Shop, Distributive and Allied Employees', the Federated Storemen and Packers' and the Federated Liquor and Allied Industries unions. The Federated Clerks' Union of Australia, a union of non-manual workers but one which has always been part of the ACTU and which is affiliated with the ALP in New South Wales, has also grown rapidly, though its membership fell towards the end of the 1970s. And, finally, there are a few other unions of manual workers such as the Builders Labourers' Federation and the Amalgamated Society of Carpenters and Joiners of Australia, which have also more than kept pace with the overall growth of union membership.

Nevertheless, the general tendency of non-manual unionism to grow much more rapidly, with consequences for many aspects of unionism, is very clear. Though this change can be regarded as characteristic of the 1970s as a decade, it showed most clearly during the early 1970s. Detailed inspection of Table 1 will show that changes in the membership of individual unions since 1976 have not followed such a clear pattern. It remains the case that unions in the manufacturing industry declined in size and that most, though not all, non-manual unions continued to grow. However, these changes are not as consistent or as marked, and we may now be seeing a period of consolidation of union membership along the new lines which developed during the years up to 1976.

REGISTRATION UNDER STATE AND FEDERAL LEGISLATION

A very large majority - probably over 90 per cent - of unionists belong to unions which are registered under state or federal legislation, and some unions may be affected by legislation even though not formally registered under it. This gives rise to situations of appalling complexity and difficulty which, fortunately, it is not our task to confront here. We are concerned with such legislation because it is important to know whether a union has placed itself within particular systems of federal or state arbitration and also because, in some cases, reports of the operation of these Acts provide a useful source of information about union membership.

Trade Unions Acts

At various times between 1876 and 1902 all the Australian colonial (or later, state) parliaments enacted legislation based on the British Trade Union Act of 1871, which included provision for unions to be registered. There has never been any equivalent federal legislation since the Commonwealth lacks the constitutional power to legislate with respect to trade unions as such. Queensland and South Australia have since repealed their trade union Acts, though some of their provisions have been continued within the state arbitration Acts.

In most states, these Acts have attracted little attention. Their provisions for registration have been largely disregarded, except in New South Wales. A handful of unions are registered under the trade union Acts of Victoria and of Tasmania, and registration under these Acts has been so insignificant for so long that on this occasion we have not shown these registrations in the Handbook. Registrations under the Western Australian Trade Unions Act are somewhat more numerous but hardly more significant. The most recent published list (Western Australian Industrial Gazette 1979, Vol. 59, Part 1, p. 111) shows 9 registered unions with a total membership of 13840, or about 6 per cent of all the unionists in the state. Why these few unions are registered under this Act while the great majority are not has seemed entirely mysterious.

This leaves only the New South Wales Trade Union Act for consideration, and it is much more important than the others on two counts. More simply, it leads to the production as a parliamentary paper of an annual report by the state Industrial Registrar which includes membership figures for all registered unions together with some basic information about their finances. The most recently published of these reports is for 1977, and appears as paper No. 16 of the 1977-78-79 session of the parliament of New South Wales. It shows 125 registered unions of employees, with a total membership of 783135 and total funds of \$39473911. Figures are published for each union, and according to industrial categories.

The other and more substantial reason for the importance of this Act is that it is essentially related to the state arbitration system. Unlike the other arbitration Acts, the New South Wales Industrial Arbitration Act does not provide for the incorporation of bodies which register under it and makes registration under the Trade Union Act a prerequisite for registration under the arbitration Act. The legal status of being a registered trade union is therefore essential to bodies seeking to make use of the state arbitration system, whereas in other states it is entirely, or very largely, superfluous. As of June 1979, there were 119 employees' unions registered under the Trade Union Act. This number is reduced by 6 if we do not include intra-state branches of several unions which are separately registered. There were also 20 registered 'trade unions' of employers, for this Act, like all the state Trade Union Acts, provides for the registration of employers' organizations as trade unions. As of December 1977, the employees' organizations registered under the Act had a total of 783135 members.

There were eleven New South Wales unions registered only under the Trade Union Act. Most of these were small unions, at any rate within New South Wales. However, they also included two important building trade unions; the Amalgamated Society of Carpenters and Joiners of Australia and the Australian Building Construction Employees and Builders Labourers' Federation.

Arbitration Acts

The most important of these acts is, of course, the federal Conciliation and Arbitration Act. At the time of writing, there are 148 'organizations' of employees registered under the Act. At the end of 1979, according to the ABS figures, these federally-registered organizations included 82 per cent of all unionists. The importance of federal registration for the activities, organization and internal regulation of these bodies is very great. The number of separate organizations, the employees whom they may claim to recruit, the way in which their officials are chosen and much else are regulated by the machinery of the arbitration system and the judges, tribunals and officials who direct it.

The state arbitration systems which operate in all states except Victoria and Tasmania also involve the registration of organizations which take part in them. This provides us with further sources of information about trade

unions. The number and size of unions registered under the Western Australian Industrial Arbitration Act are reported in the state Industrial Gazette. There are 71 registered unions with a total of 238837 members, or 73 per cent of all unionists in Western Australia.

There were 75 unions registered under the Queensland Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act as of June 1980. According to our figures, their total membership was 347808, or 89 per cent of all Queensland unionists. The official returns under the Act show a total membership of 349373 as of 31 December 1979. The membership of each union is listed in a parliamentary paper, the 'Annual Report of the President of the Industrial Court of Queensland'.

There were 71 unions registered under the South Australian Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act as of February 1979, though 10 of these were separate unions of staff at individual universities and colleges of advanced education. The total membership of the registered unions was 176388, or 68 per cent of all South Australian unionists.

There were 111 employees' organizations registered under the New South Wales Industrial Arbitration Act in August 1979. Their total membership was 920242, or 88 per cent of all New South Wales unionists.

It will be seen from these figures that the same unions will often be registered under the federal Act and under one or more of the state Acts. We have not attempted to deal with the very complex legal problems associated with the registration of unions under both state and federal legislation. For certain purposes, the state branch of a federally-registered union may legally be quite distinct from the state-registered union which goes under the same name. The problems which arise from this are too difficult to be raised in a Handbook like this and in any case are far from being resolved. We have simply assumed that a federal body and the state unions which are composed of the same members make up a single organization.

The term 'organization' in a stricter sense is used to refer to bodies registered under the federal Conciliation and Arbitration Act. Registered bodies are called 'industrial unions' in New South Wales, Queensland and Western Australia and 'associations of employees' in South Australia. The Queensland Act requires industrial unions to include the words 'Union of Employees' in their official title, while it was once required that industrial unions in Western Australia include the words 'Industrial Union of Workers'. Though these terms are often found in formal lists of unions, they are usually dropped in ordinary usage and we have not included them in the titles used in the Handbook.

TRADE UNION FEDERATIONS

The Australian Council of Trade Unions is the only 'peak' organization which, in principle, seeks to include all trade unions. Before its foundation, in 1927, there was no permanent organization which sought to speak for Australian unionism at large. In most states, trade union federations were set up towards the end of the nineteenth century and they now exist in all states and in the two territories. These bodies now constitute branches of the ACTU. In most places they are called Trades and Labor Councils. The exceptions are the Labor Council of New South Wales and the Victorian Trades Hall Council.

At the time of its most recent Congress in 1979, the ACTU had 138 affiliated unions, ranging in size from the Amalgamated Metal Workers' and Shipwright's Union, with 158500 members, to the New South Wales Government Railways Canvas Workers' Union, with 16. Unions confined to one state may affiliate with the ACTU as well as with a Trades and Labor Council, but the bulk of the ACTU affiliates operate in at least two states.

The ACTU has been becoming more important over a long period, though its constitutional powers over the actions of its affiliated unions are very limited. One reason for its greater importance is that it has come to include a higher proportion of the total number of trade unionists. During 1979, the ACTU's membership increased dramatically. This was principally due to its absorption of the former Australian Council of Salaried and Professional Associations (ACSPA), a federation of non-manual unions established in 1957. Of fourteen new affiliates of the ACTU between 1977 and 1979, all but three were former ACSPA affiliates. The ACTU made a net gain of 180000 from these new affiliations, nearly all of this coming from new affiliations of teachers, nurses, municipal officers and insurance employees.

At the time of 1979 Congress, the ACTU's own figure for its total affiliated membership was 2365875. Our figure is very similar, at 2330618. Whatever the precise figure, it represents a considerable gain in ACTU membership. According to our figures, the ACTU comprises 83 per cent of all unionists, compared to about 70 per cent in 1976. In addition 3 per cent of unionists belong to unions affiliated with a state Trades and Labor Council but not with the ACTU directly, so that 86 per cent have some connection with the ACTU.

The other important 'peak' body at the federal level is the Council of Australian Government Employee Organisations. This is made up of unions whose members are employed by the federal government, both in the public service and in certain federal public corporations. The latter are Australia Post, Telecom, the Australian Broadcasting Commission and the Commonwealth Bank. CAGEO has 25 affiliates, 8 of which are also affiliated with the ACTU. In all but four cases, all the members of affiliated unions are federal governments employees. Where this is not so, the union is affiliated with respect only to its federal government-employed members, so that the Building Workers' Industrial Union, which has a total of 47400 members, is affiliated with CAGEO

in respect of only 630. CAGEO's affiliated membership is 225000, of whom about 40 per cent belong to the unions which are also affiliated with the ACTU. CAGEO has decided in principle in favour of merging with the ACTU, and this may occur in 1981.

The largest single union which is now totally independent is the Australian Bank Employees' Union which, shortly before the disbanding of ACSPA as a separate organization, decided by a ballot of members against joining the ACTU. Now that ACSPA, to which the ABEU belonged, has disappeared, the question of ACTU affiliation is likely to be raised again.

AFFILIATION WITH THE ALP

There have been very few new union affiliations with the ALP during the last forty years. This has been recognised within the ALP itself. A discussion paper prepared for a National Commission of Inquiry into the party in 1978 reported:

In so far as the ALP's relationship with the trade union movement is concerned, it is noteworthy that the unions affiliated are basically the same unions as were affiliated with the Party in the early years of this century, and the dramatic changes in the composition of the workforce and the structure of trade unions have not been reflected in new union affiliation with the ALP. In 1978, the union connection is basically with the blue collar trade union movement and with a numerically declining section of the Australian workforce. In organisational terms, it is arguable that one of the greatest failures of the ALP has been its inability to attract affiliation in the growth areas of trade unionism, such as the technical, professional and white collar areas (APSA 1978:86).

It is not part of our task here to try to explain such a development; but Table 2 (see above p. 11) shows its effect.

Unions cannot affiliate with the ALP at the national level; they can affiliate only in one or more states and territories. Unions will not, of course, be affiliated in states where they do not operate; but they may be affiliated in some, but not all, of the states in which they do operate. Thus in some cases, including some of the largest unions, there is not a simple answer to whether the union is affiliated with the ALP.

This is the subject on which we suffer most from gaps in our information. The South Australian branch of the ALP, as in 1976, politely but firmly declined to inform us which unions were affiliated with the party in that

state. It informed the unions concerned of our enquiry and some of them contacted us to say that they were in fact affiliated. We are grateful to them, but we nevertheless have had to exclude South Australian ALP affiliations from our consideration.

Few unions are so far affiliated with the relatively new ACT and Northern Territory branches of the party. There are 10 affiliations in the ACT and 5 in the Northern Territory. In nearly all cases, these are unions which consistently affiliate with the party in the states.

A number of unions, including some of the largest, are affiliated in some states but not in others. The Shop, Distributive and Allied Employees' Association, the country's second largest union is affiliated in New South Wales, Queensland, Western Australia and the ACT, which comprise 59 per cent of its total membership. It is not affiliated in Victoria or Tasmania. The Federated Ironworkers' Association is affiliated in New South Wales, which includes 62 per cent of its membership, but not in Victoria, Queensland and Tasmania, which include another 31 per cent. The Federated Clerks' Union of Australia is affiliated only in New South Wales, which contains 31 per cent of its members. The Hospital Employees' Federation of Australia is affiliated in Queensland and one of its two branches in Victoria and in Tasmania is affiliated, but not its branch in New South Wales. A similar instance involving a much smaller union is the Australian Foremen Stevedores' Association, which is affiliated in Victoria and Queensland but not in New South Wales or Western Australia. Examples like these show that the particular boundaries of union affiliation with the ALP at the present time are to some extent the product of local circumstances. There would appear to be scope for a considerable increase in affiliations even without assuming that new unions or new types of unions may affiliate in the future.

Be that as it may, the recent past has seen a decline in the proportion of ALP-affiliated unionists to the total, though it would be difficult to measure the change precisely. In 1976 we estimated that the figure was 60 per cent, a fall of about 5 per cent since 1971. This fall was due to the growth of non-affiliated unions and the simultaneous decline of many affiliated unions, especially in manufacturing. There has probably been little change since then. Our present figures, though incomplete, enable us to say something about the level of union affiliations in the states for which we have evidence. These are set out in Table 3, together with the number of affiliated unions in each state.

The figures for the proportions of ALP-affiliated unionists in these states are more accurate than the estimates which we, or anyone else, have been able to make in the past. They suggest that our previous estimates may have been too low, by perhaps 2 or 3 per cent. Despite the changes of the last decade, a clear majority of unionists are still members of ALP-affiliated unions.

There is one respect in which unions' administrative links were changed in favour of the ALP during the 1970s. This was the establishment of the Australian Labor Advisory Committee (ALAC) in 1971, the intention being to strengthen ties between unions generally and the ALP. ALAC is made up of representatives not only of the parliamentary and non-parliamentary sections of the ALP but of the ACTU and even of CAGEO (and, until its disappearance as a separate body, of ACSPA). While the union federations are quite distinct from the party, it remains the case that, through ALAC, the ACTU and CAGEO, together representing more than 90 per cent of all unionists, have a 'special relationship' with the ALP which has no counterpart in their relations with other parties.

3. Total membership figure taken from the Executive Report of the ACTU, 1979 (9 unions).
4. Figures from other sources (8 unions).

Asterisk in TOT (Total) Column

In some cases, we know that a union operates in one or more states for which we have no membership figure. An asterisk (*) appears in such places, to distinguish those cases from states where the union has no members.

Footnotes

A number beside the heading TOT (Total) indicates that there is a footnote dealing with this union. The footnotes may be found on pp. 127-30 below.

Combinations of States and Territories

A letter from A to D beside some state totals indicates that the union has informed us that this figure also includes membership from another state or territory. They are to be read as follows:

The first word in the title of many unions does nothing to indicate the nature of their membership and may be a barrier to easy identification.
