


Nursing 310

Clinical work: Onsite observation + participation in all stages of mental health care. Write paper based on symptom encountered there. Paper requirements: Compare/contrast mainstream with alternative/non-Western treatments. Scholarly sources + newspaper report.




Community health nutrition: 31 students in Spring 2008

Assess nutrition-related health status of Guilford county residents for a grant proposal (student chooses topic).


Statement of needs requires demographic, socioeconomic, and health data.
