Wofford punter Brandon Kale has signed a free-agent contract with the Carolina Panthers.

Kale averaged 40.9 yards per punt this season. It's a mark that would have placed third in the Southern Conference if he had enough attempts to qualify for listing. With Wofford setting a school record for total offense at 5,212 yards, Kale wasn't called onto the field too often to punt. He had just 20 attempts on the season with six of those being downed inside the opponent 20-yard line.

Kale becomes the second Terrier in three seasons to sign a free-agent NFL contract. Consensus All-America center Dan Williams inked a deal with the Buffalo Bills in 1998 and was a final cut of the team at the close of preseason camp.

A native of Shelby, NC, Kale was the Terriers' starting punter since the opening practice of his freshman season. He set a single-game Wofford record for average with a 52.3 mark on four punts in a 1998 game against Chattanooga. He had a 76-yard punt in that contest as it represented the third straight game that he had a kick of at least 60 yards.

Kale improved his average each of his four seasons at Wofford. He averaged 36.1 yards as a freshman, 37.8 his sophomore year, 39.3 as a junior, and 40.9 this year.

The Carolina Panthers will begin their annual summer visit to Wofford College tomorrow when their equipment trucks arrive at the Richardson Building.

The Panthers will officially commence their sixth training camp at Wofford when rookies report on Sunday with their first practice being next Monday, July 17. Veteran players arrive July 19 with the first full squad practice set for July 20. The Panthers will break camp on Aug. 16, two days before the Wofford football team reports on Aug. 18.

The Panther players will not be the only ones participating in Carolina's 2000 training camp. Fans will also get a chance to test their skills in a series of interactive games as part of the "Panthers Experience," adjacent to the practice fields. The experience is geared toward children and will be open each practice day during training camp. The games are a modified version of the highly successful NFL Experience held at recent Super Bowl venues.

All Panther practices, including the Panthers Experience, are open to the public and free. An added bonus this year is a visit by the Detroit Lions for a series of practices July 26-27.
