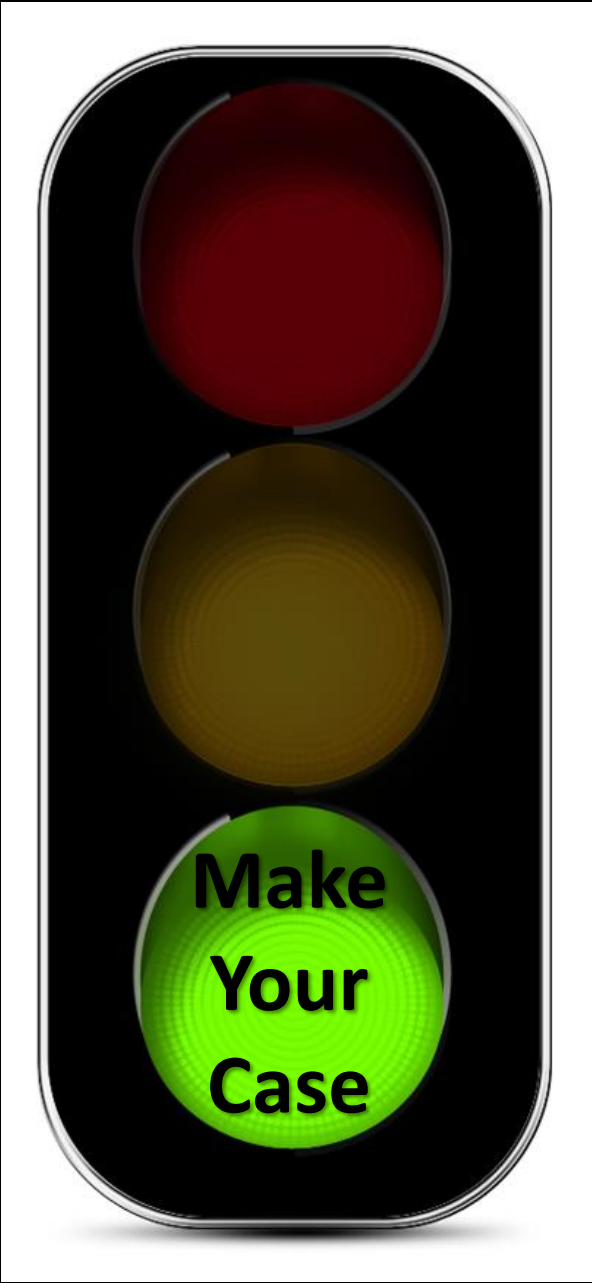
Rules of Engagement

- The loser will present a signed copy of their most important publication to the winner.

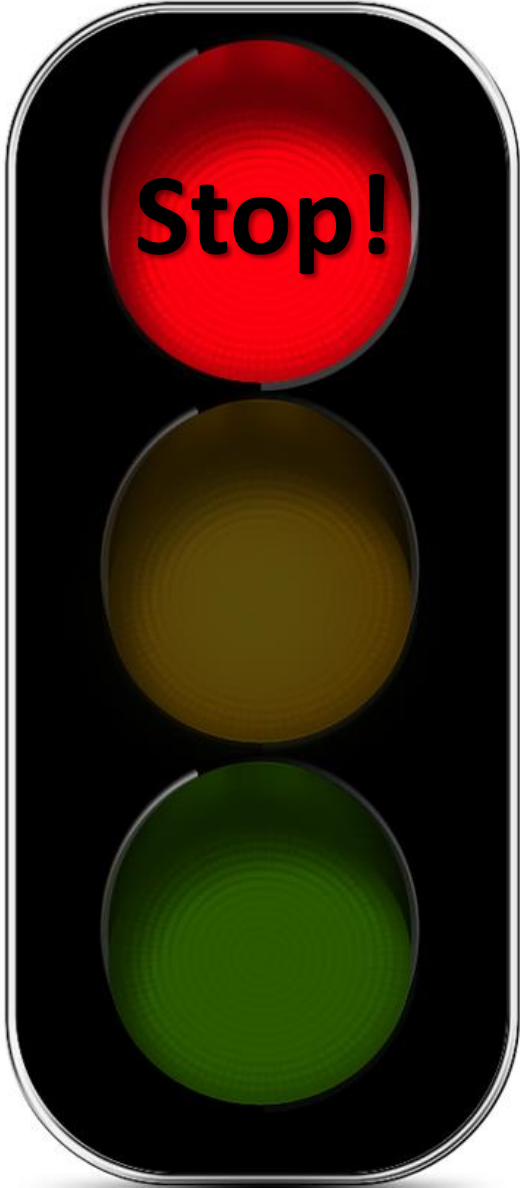
