World Health Organization announced "covid-19" as the name of this new disease on 11 February 2020.

Official names have been announced for the virus responsible for COVID-19 (previously known as "2019 novel coronavirus") and the disease it causes. The official names are:

coronavirus disease

COVID-19

severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2
(SARS-CoV-2)

In covid-19, 'CO' stands for 'corona,' 'VI' for 'virus,' and 'D' for disease. Formerly, this disease was referred to as "2019 novel coronavirus" or "2019-nCoV." There are many types of human coronaviruses including some that commonly cause mild upper-respiratory tract illnesses.
