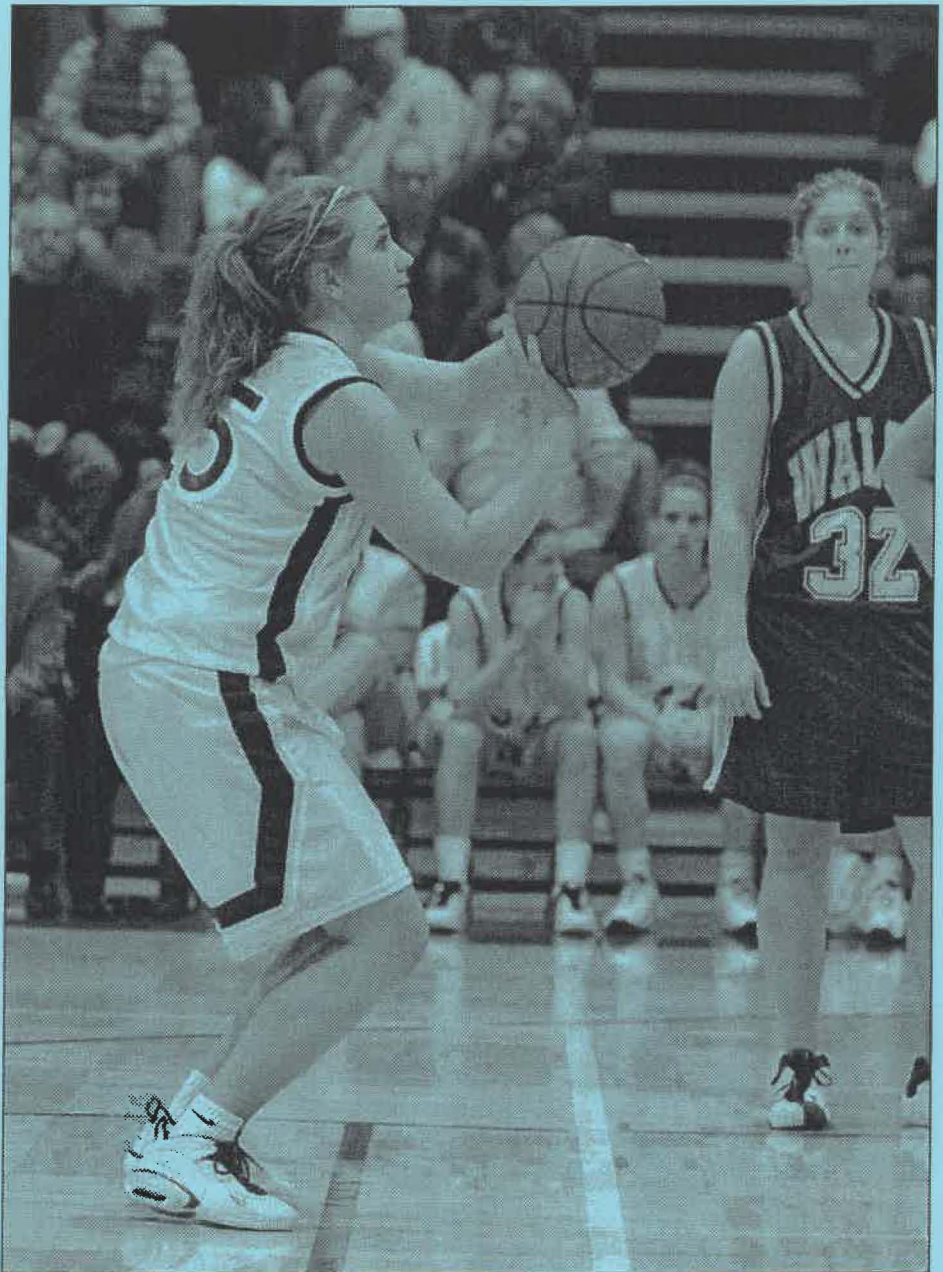

TONIGHT'S GAME

The Cedarville University women's basketball team hosts the Shawnee State University Bears – seven-time defending AMC champions – tonight in the Callan Athletic Center in American Midwest Conference South Division action. The Lady Jackets, who climbed to a best-ever #4 spot in this week's NAIA II national rankings, are 28-2 (16-1 AMC) on the season after escaping at Rio Grande 65-62 on Wednesday. The win guaranteed the Lady Jackets a share of the 2002-03 AMC South Division title and sets the stage for tonight's showdown with the Bears. A Cedarville win over Shawnee State secures an automatic bid to the NAIA National Tournament in Sioux City, Iowa on March 12-18. A win by Shawnee State forces the automatic bid to be determined by the third tie-breaker – a coin flip supervised by the AMC commissioner. Shawnee State comes into the game with a 22-5 overall mark (16-2 AMC), ranked #8 in NAIA II and winners of 14 of the last 15 games – the only loss being to CU on Feb. 6 by a 65-56 tally. The Bears lead the all-time series between the two schools by a 19-5 margin.

The Cedarville University Lady Jackets enter tonight's contest in the midst of a school-record 18-game winning streak – their last loss coming over ten weeks ago on Dec. 7 to Ohio Dominican. The Lady Jackets are led by All-America center Kirsten Rossotti. The 6-0 senior, the AMC's Player of the Week (Feb. 10-16), is Cedarville's all-time leading scorer and rebounder. Rossotti paces the team with a 20.6 ppg scoring average and 9.8 rebounds per contest. Julie Stauffer, a 5-6 junior guard, has a 14.9 ppg average, is tied for first in three-point FG's (62) and ranks second in assists (121). Sophomore guard Kari Flunker is the only other Lady Jacket scoring in double figures with 14.0 ppg while adding a team-leading 145 assists. Freshman forward Emily Delimpo is second in rebounding with 6.6 boards per game and fourth in scoring with 8.6 points per night.

Shawnee State is led by sophomore Heather Schilling. The 5-6 guard – the AMC's Freshman of the Year last season – is scoring 15.8 points per game and leads the Bears in shooting from behind the arc (75-212). Angie Ingram, a 6-0 senior center, adds 11.6 points to the attack while grabbing over 7 rebounds per game. The only other Bear in double figures is Camey Geiman, a 5-8 junior forward, contributing 10.6 points and a team-leading 8.3 rebounds per game.

LAST TIME OUT

Feb. 19 at Rio Grande

Julie Stauffer scored 22 points, including a go ahead three-pointer with 20 seconds to play, as NAIA Division II No. 4 Cedarville escaped Rio Grande, 65-62, for their 18th consecutive victory in American Midwest Conference South Division action. The win guarantees the Lady Jackets of at least a share of the division title. The Jackets trailed 60-54 with 3:45 to play before beginning their comeback. Kirsten Rossotti, who finished with 14 points, hit two free throws at the 3:20 mark and rookie Emily Delimpo converted a layup one minute later to trim the deficit to 60-58. Following a basket by the Redwomen with 1:55 to go, Rossotti and Kari Flunker each made one-of-two free throws to keep the deficit at two points, 62-60. Rio missed the front end of a one-and-one free throw situation with 38 seconds on the clock setting up Stauffer's winning trey. The Redwomen called timeout with 11 seconds remaining to set up a final shot. Rossotti rebounded the errant attempt, Flunker was ultimately fouled, and then she sealed the outcome with two free throws with just three ticks to go. Stauffer and Rossotti were the only CU players to score in double figures. Delimpo pulled down a team-high 10 rebounds as the Jackets finished unbeaten on the road in AMC play for the regular season.

LOOKING AHEAD

The result of tonight's game determines the post-season schedule for the Lady Jackets. Should Cedarville defeat Shawnee State, the Lady Jackets clinch the AMC South title and an automatic bid to the NAIA II national tournament in Sioux City, Iowa, on March 12-18. Cedarville will travel to Saint Vincent, the AMC North champ, to play for the AMC Championship on Saturday, March 1, and then prepare for the the NAIA II tournament. If Shawnee State wins tonight's game, a coin flip will determine the AMC South champion and the automatic national tournament bid. If the Lady Jackets lose the coin flip, they will host an AMC first-round tournament game on Tuesday, Feb. 25 against the fifth-place team from the north division. The winner of the 8-team AMC tournament also receives an automatic bid to the NAIA II national tournament.

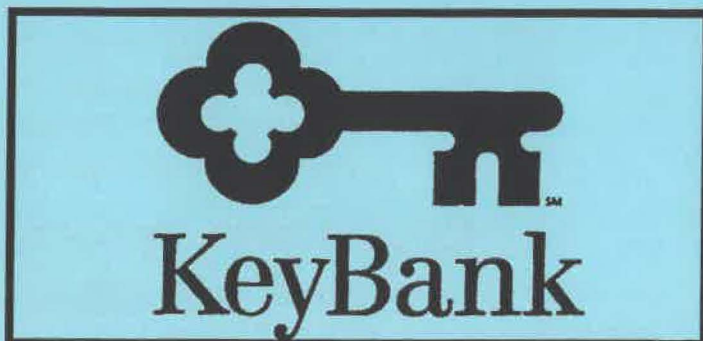

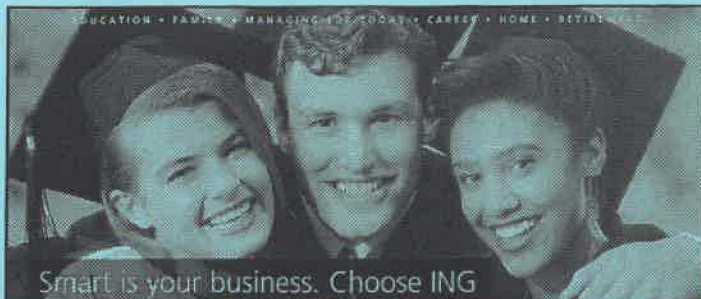

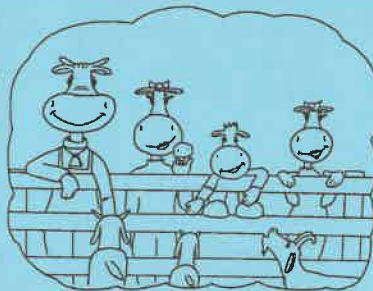
