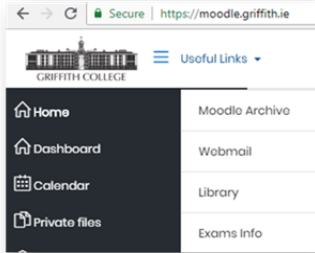

Many members of staff have now successfully "rolled over" their 2017/18 Moodle content from <https://moodlearchive.griffith.ie> to the new pages which are available via ... <https://moodle.griffith.ie> Just a reminder to those who have yet to complete this simple process; another way to access the archive pages is to go to your new home page on Moodle and click on the Useful Links "drop-down" arrow (see below) and choose Moodle Archive. Please take this opportunity to refresh your Moodle content and implement programme review changes.

Summary of key points:

- The Moodle that will be live September 1<sup>st</sup> each year will no longer automatically contain existing resources & materials from the previous year.
- June 1<sup>st</sup> each year <https://moodlearchive.griffith.ie> made available to lecturers and staff (not students)
- Moodle.griffith.ie continues to run as is throughout the summer to facilitate summer courses, repeat exams etc.
- Moodle.griffith.ie becomes moodle.griffith.ie
- 1<sup>st</sup> September moodlearchive.griffith.ie becomes moodle.griffith.ie and is live for all, student
- The material that was on the previous years' Moodle is archived and kept available for 12 months (for e.g. on moodle1718.griffith.ie).

PDs were briefed on this in February and I would ask you now to inform your broader faculty staff of this plan.

We will be sending out a similar communication shortly to all lecturers and Greg and Alice will be in touch with the workshop dates over the coming weeks.

A.R.M. or **Annual Roll-out of Moodle** is a new IT services initiative, supported by the Digital Learning Department. In short this will mean that a new Moodle page for every module is created in the system from the 1<sup>st</sup> of June, which can be structured and populated with fresh content over the summer months, ready to “go live” from the beginning of September each year. This is an opportunity to refresh Moodle materials and implement any annual programme review recommendations. The IT and e-learning team appreciated the positive response to A.R.M. when introduced at the last P.D.s meeting in February.
