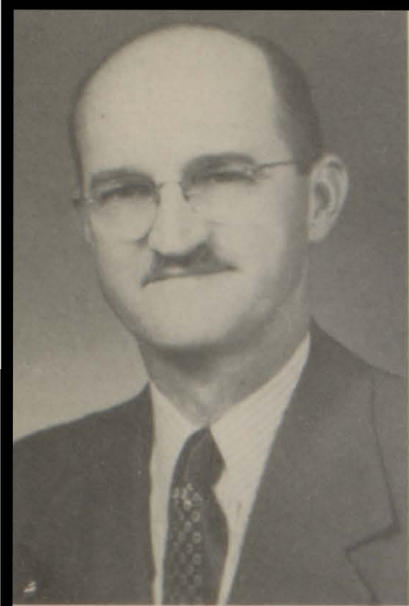
### OUR PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

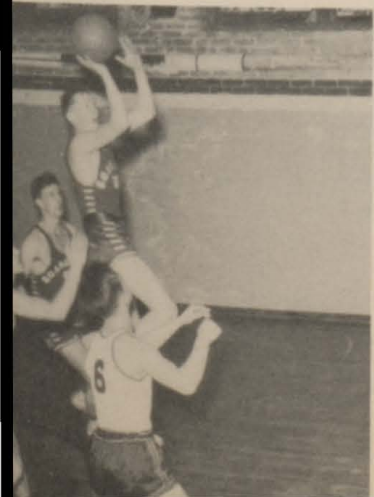
## BOYS' BASKETBALL

Our Jay-Vees showed marked improvement over the season and will certainly add depth to next year's team.

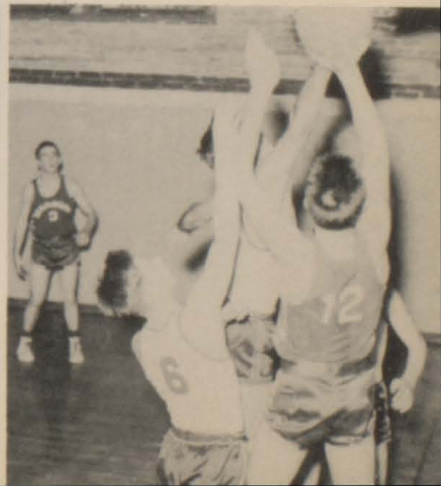
