This thesis examines the external factors causing and supporting hikikomori behavior. The purpose of this study was to find out the external factors in Japanese society, and the supporting cause of hikikomori behavior. The data analyzed in this thesis is a comic NHK ni Youkoso which story was written by Tatsuhiko Takimoto and illustrations drawn by Kendi Oiwa. The data analysis is reinforced by the theory books *Amae no Kozou* by Takeo Doi, *Japanese Society* by Chie Nakane, and *Nihon teki Shuudanshuugi- sono shinka o tou* by Eshun Hamaguchi, to find the characteristics of Japanese society as a community groups society. The results of the data analysis indicate that there are some external factors in Japanese society, and the supporting cause hikikomori behavior, namely: a. Ijime; b. wrong social contact; c. comfort of technology, and d. Abandoned by the surrounding environment. All of these factors are external factors in Japanese society groups, and supporting cause of hikikomori behavior, where hikikomori act rebellious and alienated from society.
