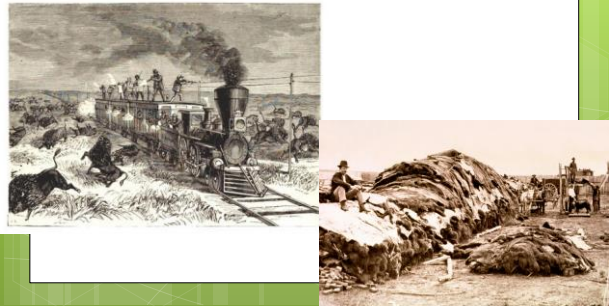
Puppets can carry:

TRACKS NOT TO SCALE
Depending on the substrate (snow, mud, dust, sand, etc.) and the speed the animal was moving, tracks may show great variability in their appearance.

F - Front track
H - Hind track
T - Tail marks may be present
