




### Wheaton College

#### Wheaton OER Adoptions By Semester







- Spring 2018: Round Table featuring Student Advocates
- Summer 2018: Finding and Vetting OER
- Fall 2018: OER Adoption in four core courses for a savings of \$30,381.82
- Spring 2019: ongoing OER Adoption in core courses and one additional course for an anticipated savings of \$39,840
