
Principal's Message

Once again, for your enjoyment and as a memento of the students and the events at W.D. Lowe Technical in 1968, we present The Towers.



I extend my gratitude to Jim Waley and Norm Savage, whom without their assistance, the publication of the Towers, would have been impossible.



Monday, for the first time in its 48-year history, the scene of the annual Windsor Secondary Schools Association track and field meet shifted from Windsor Stadium.


The University of Windsor's South Campus complex at Huron Line and College Ave., became the new home of this giant cinder show and the 600-odd prep thinclads obviously enjoyed their plush surroundings as they established 18 meet records during the day-long, 92-event program.

Sixteen of the standards which tumbled had been recorded during the past six years. But. a 29-year-old junior boys' long jump mark and a 12-year-old junior boys' high jump record also were shattered.

The "oldies" were attacked by a couple of talented W.D. Lowe Technical School youngsters, Tom Dufault and Dave Bigness, who finished one-two in the race for the junior boys' individual championship.

Dufault added two inches to the long jump record of 21 feet, 5½ inches which had been set by Forster (Sandwich) Collegiate great Jack Parry in 1939.

Bigness soared 6 feet, 1 inch in the high jump competition to add 1¼ inches to the standard which had been put into the record book by Richard O'Connor of Assumption High School in 1956.
