

## Nadav Morag, PhD Instructor Center for Homeland Defense and Security

Nadav Morag is a faculty member at the Center for Homeland Defense and Security (CHDS) at the United States Naval Postgraduate School in Monterey, California. He teaches senior federal, State and local homeland security officials selected and funded by the Department of Homeland Security within the context of the center's MA in Homeland Security program- this is the only program in the country under the auspices of DHS.

Nadav also serves as a member of the LA and Orange County Sheriff's Departments' Homeland Security Advisory Council and is a member of the LA County Terrorism Early Warning Group.

In 2001, Nadav took up a position, initially as Senior Director for Domestic Policy and subsequently as Senior Director for Foreign Policy, at Israel's National Security Council.

At the Israeli NSC, Nadav worked with a team of ten other senior officials from the Israeli Military, Domestic Security Service, Mossad, Foreign Ministry and Police developing policy recommendations based on intelligence and other sources for then Prime Minister Ariel Sharon on matters of national security including counterterrorism policy, bilateral security relations with a number of regional countries and Europe and the development of a national security policy for the Israeli national police.

He also served as a reserve officer in the Israel Defense Forces (IDF) in the areas of education/training and subsequently in the Army Spokesperson's Office as an advisor to the chief spokesperson of the IDF on public affairs, media relations and strategic communications.

He has authored articles and book chapters on terrorism, strategy and the Middle East including: "The Economic and Social Effects of Intensive Terrorism: Israel 2000-2004" (*Middle East Review of International Affairs*), "Measuring Success in Coping with Terrorism: The Israeli Case" (*Studies in Conflict and Terrorism*), "The National Military Strategic Plan for the War on Terrorism: An Assessment," (*Homeland Security Affairs*), and "Unambiguous Ambiguity: The Opacity of the Oslo Peace Process" (in *Israel: The First Hundred Years, Volume II: From War to Peace?*, Frank Cass, 2000).

# Seth G. Jones, PhD Instructor Center for Homeland Defense and Security

Seth G. Jones is a Political Scientist at the RAND Corporation and an Adjunct Professor at the U.S. Naval Postgraduate School and Georgetown University's Edmund A. Walsh School of Foreign Service. He has focused on counterinsurgency and counterterrorism missions, including U.S. operations in Afghanistan and Pakistan, and has served as a consultant to the Department of Defense, Department of State, and White House.

Seth has conducted on-the-ground field research on al Qa'ida and other groups in Afghanistan and Pakistan for the U.S. government over a dozen times since 2003. He has briefed senior White House officials on the terrorist threat to the United States from Afghanistan / Pakistan, and has briefed senior European officials on counterinsurgency operations in Afghanistan and Pakistan, as well as the terrorist threat emanating from Afghanistan and Pakistan.

He is the author of "In the Graveyard of Empires: America's War in Afghanistan" (W.W. Norton, forthcoming), as well as "The Rise of European Security Cooperation" (Cambridge University Press, 2007). He has published a range of journal articles in International Security, The National Interest, Security Studies, Chicago Journal of International Law, International Affairs, and Survival, as well as such newspapers and magazines as The New York Times, Newsweek, Financial Times, and International Herald Tribune. He received his MA and PhD from the University of Chicago.

## Paul J. Smith Instructor Center for Homeland Defense and Security

Paul joined the British Army upon leaving school in 1973. Following training at the Royal Military Academy Sandhurst he was commissioned into the Royal Regiment of Fusiliers, an infantry regiment. During the next 20 years, Paul served in a variety of operational and staff postings in the UK, West Germany and Cyprus. Between 1975-78 he attended Bristol University and was awarded a BA(Honours) degree in History.

Paul completed 5 operational tours in Northern Ireland during the 1970s and 1980s. His final posting in the Army was as Military Assistant to the Assistant Chief of the Defence Staff (NATO/UK) during the Gulf War, the Yugoslavia Crisis and the collapse of Communism.

Upon retiring from the Army in 1993, Paul joined the British Security Service (MI5). After initial training he was posted to the Counter Espionage section where he was the case officer for the successful prosecution of Michael John Smith (no relation!), a spy run by the SVR. His next posting was to the Service's Technical Operations Branch. Here he planned and executed technical operations for 3 years against a range of targets at home and abroad. There followed a 2 year secondment to SIS (MI6) investigating British criminals and drug dealers abroad. Upon return from the SIS, Paul was posted to New Scotland Yard as the Service's representative within the Metropolitan Police. During the next 4 years he worked with the Metropolitan Police on a wide variety of international and Irish investigations. From there Paul served as head of one of the Service's operational sections in Northern Ireland.

In 2005, Paul was posted to the British Embassy in Washington, D.C. and served as Deputy MI5 liaison officer to the US intelligence community. In this capacity he played a major role for MI5 with the US intelligence community during the OVERT (AQ trans-Atlantic airline plot) investigation.

Paul is retiring from the British Security Service in the summer of 2008 and has taken a position as an instructor in the "Comparative Government for Homeland Security" course at the Center for Homeland Defense and Security, US Naval Postgraduate School.

#### Online Course: The Global Jihadi Threat

The Global Jihadi Threat course was developed by CHDS faculty member Dr. Nadav Morag. The course is derived from graduate-level course material used within the Comparative Government for Homeland Security course he teaches at the Naval Postgraduate School.

<u>Course Description</u>: Islam is a faith of richness and complexity that has manifested itself over time in a broad variety of ways. Unfortunately, it is also used as the basis for the violent ideologies of the Global Jihad. Understanding the fundamentals behind the religion (as well as concepts such as Jihad), the background with respect to the Islamic community's relationship to the West, the position of Muslims in modern-day Western societies, and the various permutations of extremist Islamic ideologies is critical in helping policy makers, law enforcement personnel, and governmental administrators at various levels relate to Islam and Muslims in an informed manner while also being able to effectively counteract extremist activities and ideas.

The course is comprised of five modules:

- > Islam: Basic Principles, Origins and Divisions
  - Focuses on the basic principles of Islam, the origins of the faith and role of the Prophet Muhammad, and fundamental schisms
- > The Role of Jihad in Islam
  - Focuses on the role of Jihad in the Islamic faith
- > Islamic Civilization and the Western Challenge
  - Focuses on the historic relationship between Islam and the West and Muslim attempts to address and cope with the reality of contemporary Muslim weakness in the face of Western power
- > The Development of Islamic Extremism
  - Focuses on the development of Islamic extremism from Muhammad Ibn Abd al-Wahab to Osama Bin Laden
- > Islam in the West: Integration, Isolation, Radicalization
  - Focuses on the role of Islam and Muslims in the West (particularly in Europe) and the problems involved in integration, which sometimes lead to social isolation and can help create an infrastructure for radicalization

Each module consists of a 20-30 minute online lecture, presented in multimedia format that integrates narrated audio with written text and animated graphics. A short multiple-choice quiz is included for each module to gauge student comprehension of facts and concepts presented in the lecture. A downloadable certificate of completion is available once the course is finished.

Optional components of the course include an interactive glossary of terms, additional readings, and an online discussion forum where all participants in the course can explore issues and questions regarding the topic of the Global Jihadi Threat.
