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Letter, 1862 August 4, Oscar D. Ladley to Mother and Sisters [Catherine, Mary, and Alice Ladley]

Oscar D. Ladley

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Camp near Speryodle Clar Mother y Desters, I received yours of the 24 the inst. yesterday and haster to answer. The weather is extremely hot, almost unbearable while on drill, we have Buttakion drill every day, sunday excepted, and company drill in the afternoon, megade drie once or twice a week und Division drile once a week, and a Review, or rather manouvering us if we were ingaged in agrind battle by sigets whole Command. Wanad me of the last named the other day, we cooked one days rations and marched set miles and were on our perhall day performing as in battle.

We sometimes would get a glimps of the Skinmaker away two or three miles in different directions superted by different regiment. The grandesh sight of all was to see the Cavelry make a charge in and imaginary for, They looked as if they could sweet every thing before them. Col Mi Leans was at their head in one of them 1 Charge, with Labers drawed and glistening in the sun it looked very nice. something you will not be able to see a Ohio, much les a read one. I was agouid I would ad too cate, 3 I reger to the commedian I spoke of in my letter, In you should 20 mor Harland you might sheate to him, he will have a good deal of infuence.
