The NSW AIDS Resource Distribution Formula (ARD) is a key component of the NSW AIDS Response. It is a formula that determines the distribution of funds to Local Health Districts (LHDs) based on their population and other factors. The 2008 Review of the ARD was conducted by the Centre for Health Service Development, University of Wollongong. The review found that the ARD is generally fair and equitable, but there are some areas for improvement. The review recommended that the ARD be revised to better reflect the needs of LHDs and to ensure that funds are distributed more equitably.
