BU IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the President of this Association be authorized to appear on behalf of the Association at the hearing to be held by the City Council at 10:00 &. N., Monday, December 2, 1935, and at any other marings which may be called subsequent thereto, for the surpose of stating the position of the Accociation and its reasons therefor, and

as IT FIRTHER REPOLYED, that the individual members of the Accordation be urged to attend the hearing or hearings aforesaid and to make their desires known to the City Council.
