 - a. For the year 1929, and
 - b. For the year 1940 current year.
- Present Tax and assessment delinquencies of same properties today.
- 3. Present <u>Assessment</u> delinquencies on properties between Front Avenue and River, and within the north and south boundaries of the assessment district which was assessed for Intercepting Sewer and Seawall.
