in Co I 2<sup>d</sup> Me Regt Coln G. W  
Roberts commanding. I was detailed  
as Hospital waiter & acted & done  
the duty as such untill my Hon  
Discharge which was for  
Disability to act & do the duty  
of a Soldier <sup>for</sup> which I did not  
enlist for. I enlisted as Co Cook  
& Capt White enrolled my name  
as such. I now petition you  
Hon. to give me a place as  
Hospital waiter as I am some  
what acquainted with the business

& am willing to do all in my  
power to aide in helping put  
down this Rebellion.
